AN ACT TO TRANSFER LOT NO. 258, MUNICIPALITY OF *PITI*, TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PARKS AND RECREATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF EXPANDING THE FOOTPRINT AND CAPACITY OF THE VICENTE A. LIMTIACO MEMORIAL PARK.

#### BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

- 2 Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. I Liheslaturan Guåhan finds
- 3 that, according to a site visit conducted on January 31 with officials from the
- 4 Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), the Vicente A. Limtiaco Memorial Park,

- located in the Tiguac area of Nimitz Hill, Piti, is nearly at its maximum capacity,
- 2 prioritizing the duty of the Government of Guam to plan for an essential expansion
- 3 of burial plots in order to prevent turning grieving local families away when seeking
- 4 a place to lay their loved ones to rest.
- As the only municipal cemetery on Guam, the Vicente A. Limtiaco Memorial
- 6 Park provides the most affordable option to Guam residents, which can save families
- 7 the added heartache and burden caused when trying to purchase a funeral plot or
- 8 crypt at a private cemetery a cost that may require additional debt or third-party
- 9 fundraising on the part of the deceased's family.
- 10 I Liheslaturan Guåhan additionally finds an unassigned government-owned
- lot adjacent to the Tiguac-based cemetery, identified in land records as Lot No. 258,
- which according to DPR has been recently surveyed by the Department of Land
- 13 Management (DLM), is available to expand the cemetery's current footprint,
- 14 avoiding the lengthy, bureaucratic process of locating and opening up a new
- 15 cemetery in another village.
- DPR reported during the same January 31 site visit that utilizing the adjacent
- 17 lot could result in an additional 5 years of capacity for the Vicente A. Limtiaco
- 18 Memorial Park.
- Therefore, it is the intention of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to transfer this adjacent
- 20 lot to DPR, as the first step in expanding this necessary community resource, and
- 21 allow the department staff to begin seeking funding from local and federal sources
- 22 to develop and construct the necessary infrastructure and capital improvements that
- 23 will fulfill their mission to provide affordable funeral plots to local families.
- Section 2. Designated Use of Property. The use of Lot No. 258, in the
- 25 Municipality of Piti, shall be consistent with the purpose of expanding the Vicente
- A. Limtiaco Memorial Park and shall prioritize the construction of crypts, and shall
- 27 not be utilized for any other program or duty under the Department of Parks and

- 1 Recreation.
- 2 Section 3. Transfer of Property. Administrative jurisdiction of Lot No.
- 3 258, in the Municipality of Piti, consisting of a computed area of Forty-five Thousand
- 4 Seven Hundred Ninety-Three (45,793) square meters as shown on Map No. 994957
- 5 (Lot), is hereby granted to the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR), for the
- 6 purpose of expanding the Vicente A. Limtiaco Memorial Park. A survey map
- 7 designating the area of Forty-five Thousand Seven Hundred Ninety-Three (45,793)
- 8 square meters (Map) for the property has been prepared, recorded, and provided by
- 9 the Department of Land Management for DPR. A copy of the Map is attached hereto
- 10 as Exhibit A.
- 11 Section 4. Issuance of Certificate of Title. The Department of Land
- 12 Management (DLM) shall issue a certificate of title for Lot No. 258 in the name of
- 13 the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) as owner in fee simple so long as the
- 14 Lot is used to expand the Vicente A. Limtiaco Memorial Park. If the use of Lot No.
- 15 258 is inconsistent with the purposes stated in Section 1 of this Act, then Lot No.
- 16 258 shall automatically revert to the government of Guam. These covenants shall be
- 17 contained in any certificate of title or deed issued by DLM to DPR under this Act.
- 18 Section 5. Exemption from Appraisals. 2 Guam Code Annotated §
- 19 2107(b) and the Standing Rules of I Mina'trentai Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan,
- 20 relative to land appraisals, shall not apply to this Act.
- Section 6. Required Memorandum of Understanding for Cemetery
- 22 Maintenance.
- Within one hundred twenty (120) days following the enactment of this Act,
- 24 the Department of Parks and Recreation (DPR) and the Department of Public Works
- 25 (DPW) and shall execute a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) that shall clearly
- 26 delineate the respective responsibilities of DPR and DPW for the development,
- 27 operation, maintenance, and care of the Vicente A. Limtiaco Memorial Park,

1	Municipality of Piti.					
2	The MOU shall, at a minimum, provide for:					
3	(a)	the allocation of personnel, equipment, and funding for ongoing				
4	cemetery maintenance and burials; and					
5	(b)	schedules and standards for grounds maintenance, repairs, and				
6	improvements.					
7	A fully executed copy of the MOU shall be transmitted to the Speaker of I					
8	Liheslaturan Guåhan and filed with the Legislative Secretary and the Department of					
9	Land Management within ten (10) days of its execution.					
10	Section 7.	Masterplan and Funding Needs. The Department of Parks and				
11	Recreation shall	develop and present a masterplan and funding needed to $I$				
12	Liheslatura for its implementation within one (1) year upon enactment.					
13	Section 8.	Severability. If any provision of this Act or its application to any				
14	person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not					
15	affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without					
16	the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are					
17	severable.
