**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 60.80(b) OF CHAPTER 60, TITLE
8, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
PROHIBITING PLEA DEALS WITHOUT REASONABLE
PROOF OF VICTIM NOTIFICATION.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Plea Bargaining Regulated. Subsection (b) of § 60.80 of Chapter 60, Title 8, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby *amended*, to read:

“(b) If a plea agreement has been reached by the parties which contemplates entry of a plea of guilty or nolo contendere in the expectation

1 that a specified sentence will be imposed or that other charges before the court
2 will be dismissed, the court shall require the disclosure of the agreement in
3 open court at the time the plea is offered. Thereupon, the court may accept or
4 reject the agreement, or may defer its decision as to acceptance or rejection
5 until there has been an opportunity to consider the presentence report. No plea
6 agreement shall be accepted by the court unless the agreement includes a
7 certification by a victim advocate of the Office of the Attorney General's
8 Crime Victim's Response Unit assigned to the case, affirming one of the
9 following:

10 (1) the victim has been notified of the terms of the plea
11 agreement and has indicated agreement; or

12 (2) the victim has been notified of the terms of the plea
13 agreement and has indicated disagreement; or

14 (3) reasonable and documented attempts were made to notify
15 the victim of the terms of the plea agreement, but the victim did not
16 respond; or

17 (4) reasonable and documented attempts were made to notify
18 the victim of the terms of the plea agreement, but the victim could not
19 be located.

20 Such certification shall be attached to the plea agreement submitted to
21 the court, and the court shall not accept any plea agreement lacking such
22 certification."
