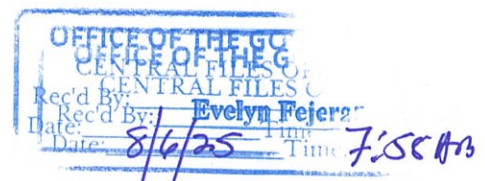

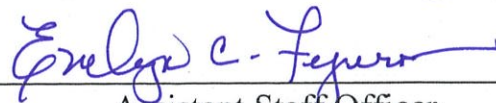

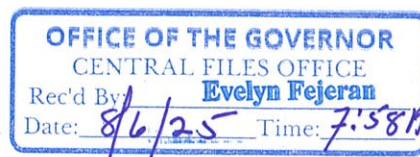

**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 403(n) OF CHAPTER 4, TITLE 1,
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
CHANGING THE OFFICIAL NAME OF THE
MUNICIPALITY OF “ASAN” TO ITS NAME IN THE
CHAMORU LANGUAGE, NAMELY “ASSAN-MA’INA.”**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the villages of Asan and Maina hold deep historical and cultural significance to the CHamoru people and the island of Guam. *Asan* and *Maina* have long been recognized by their native CHamoru names – “*Assan*” and “*Ma’ina*” – by local residents, historians, and cultural practitioners. These names reflect the unique

1 heritage, linguistic identity, and ancestral ties of the CHamoru people to the land and
2 the villages they call home.

3 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that in response to a request made by
4 Senator Telo T. Taitague to restore the villages' names to their native forms, the
5 Asan-Maina Municipal Planning Council took formal action to express their support
6 for the name change. On August 12, 2021, during its regularly scheduled meeting,
7 the Council unanimously approved a motion to adopt Resolution No.2021-01 and
8 rename "*Asan*" to "*Assan*" and "*Maina*" to "*Ma'ina*" to better reflect the traditional
9 CHamoru spellings and pronunciations.

10 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to honor the expressed
11 wishes of the Asan-Maina Municipal Planning Council and the people of the villages
12 by officially recognizing the names "*Assan*" and "*Ma'ina*" as the proper and
13 culturally appropriate designations for these communities.

14 **Section 2.** § 403(n) of Chapter 4, Title 1, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby
15 *amended* to read:

16 "(n) Municipality of *Assan-Ma'ina*. Beginning at the mouth of the
17 Fonte River (*Pigo*) running southeasterly along said River to the base of Mt.
18 *Macajna*, thence southerly along said base of mountain and along the eastern
19 boundary of Lot No. 450 to the *Lonfit* River at the Place of *Jangga*, thence
20 westerly along the *Lonfit* River to Mt. *Chachao*, thence northerly to the head
21 of *Matgue* River, thence northerly along said River to its mouth, thence
22 northeasterly along the coast line to the point of beginning."

23 **Section 3.** All references to "*Asan*" in the Guam Code Annotated and the
24 laws, rules, and regulations of Guam shall be understood to refer to "*Assan-Ma'ina*."

25 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
26 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
27 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without

1 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
2 severable.

3 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
