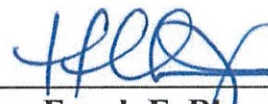

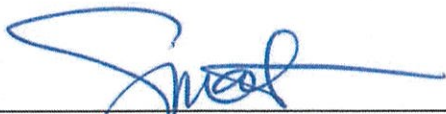
CERTIFICATION OF PASSAGE OF AN ACT TO I MAGA'HÅGAN GUÅHAN

**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF NINETEEN
MILLION SEVEN HUNDRED FORTY-FIVE THOUSAND
SEVEN HUNDRED FOURTEEN DOLLARS (\$19,745,714)
FROM THE GENERAL FUND REALIZED FROM BOND
REFUNDING SAVINGS NOT FACTORED INTO THE
FISCAL YEAR 2026 BUDGET FOR CAPITAL
IMPROVEMENT PROJECTS AND LIFE SAVING
SUPPLIES AND MATERIALS AT THE GUAM
MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the Government of Guam has realized debt service savings of approximately

1 Nineteen Million Seven Hundred Forty-Five Thousand, Four-Hundred Seventeen
2 Dollars (\$19,745,417) from the refunding of government Business Privilege Tax
3 bonds, Series 2025G, series 2015D that were not factored into the Fiscal Year 2026
4 budget. These savings present an opportunity to address critical infrastructure needs
5 at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA). Any additional future savings
6 from this bond refunding should be appropriated to the Guam Memorial Hospital
7 Authority (GMHA) upon its availability.

8 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that the Guam Memorial Hospital
9 Authority has numerous urgent capital improvement needs that directly impact
10 patient care and safety. The hospital's aging infrastructure, including electrical
11 systems, fire protection systems, elevators, and information technology
12 infrastructure, requires immediate attention to ensure the continued delivery of
13 quality healthcare services to the people of Guam.

14 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* recognizes that pursuant to Title 5 GCA, Chapter 1,
15 savings achieved through bond refunding may be allocated toward capital
16 improvements relating to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and other health-
17 related matters, subject to an appropriation by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*.

18 Therefore, it is the intent of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to appropriate these
19 realized savings specifically for capital improvement projects and life-saving
20 supplies and materials at the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority and other health-
21 related facilities, with strict prohibitions against using these funds for personnel costs
22 or hiring.

23 **Section 2. Appropriation.**

24 (a) The sum of Nineteen Million Dollars Seven Hundred Forty-Five
25 Thousand Seven Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$19,745,714) is hereby appropriated
26 from the General Fund, representing savings realized from bond refunding not
27 factored into the Fiscal Year 2026 budget, to the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority

1 for the following capital improvement project categories and life-saving supplies
2 and materials:

3 (1) Five Million One Hundred Eighty-Eight Thousand One Hundred
4 Three Dollars (\$5,188,103) for Structural & Architectural Projects: (Z Wing
5 Demolition and Retrofit, MIS Server Room Upgrade, Maternal Child Health
6 Renovation & Expansion Project, Hospital Center Island Parking Expansion);

7 (2) Seven Million Three Hundred Eleven Thousand Two Hundred
8 Fifteen Dollars (\$7,311,215) for Utility Systems Projects: (450 Ton Main
9 Chillers with cooling towers, remove and replacement of 265 Ton Back-up
10 chiller condenser, Intensive Care Unit HVAC Upgrade Project, Pharmacy
11 USP 797 and USP 800 Compliance, Pharmacy HVAC Upgrade, Roof
12 Mechanical HVAC Upgrade, Envelope Mechanical, HVAC Components,
13 Fire Alarm System & Fire Protection Upgrades for both GMH Exterior and
14 Interior, All Hazards Emergency Power Supply Project, GMH, SNF, and
15 CME Elevator projects, GMH CSR Dumbwaiters, GMH Warehouse Material
16 Lifts);

17 (3) One Million Fifty-Five Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty-Three
18 Dollars (\$1,055,833) for Alternate Care Site Projects: (Fan Coil Units, SNF
19 Chiller Pumps Redundancy System, Remove and Replace SNF HVAC
20 Chilled Water Lines);

21 (4) Three Million Nine Hundred Fifty-Nine Thousand Three
22 Hundred Thirty-Seven Dollars (\$3,959,337) for Medical Equipment:
23 Angiography Suite, Med-Surge Beds, Ventilators/Bipap Repair Parts,
24 BioSafety Hood, Cadaver Lift, Ligasure FT Series, Sterilizer, Central Patient
25 Cardiac Monitoring Project plus HER Interface, and Anesthesia Machines);

26 (5) Two Million Seventy-Four Thousand Two Hundred Forty
27 Dollars (\$2,074,240) for Information Technology projects: (Medication

1 Dispensing System, Access Control System, Picture Archiving and
2 Communication System/Radiology Information System (PACS-RIS), 15
3 KVA UPS, Emergency Handheld Radios); and

4 (6) One Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Nine Hundred Eighty-Six
5 Dollars (\$156,986) for a Medical Transport Vehicle.

6 (b) The funds appropriated in this Section shall not be used for personnel
7 costs, hiring, or any other purpose not specifically authorized herein.

8 (c) The funds appropriated in this Section shall not be subject to the
9 Governor's transfer authority.

10 (d) The funds appropriated in this Section shall not lapse and shall remain
11 available until fully expended for the purposes of this Act.

12 **Section 3. Authorization for Reprogramming of Funds.** The Guam
13 Memorial Hospital Authority (GMHA) is hereby authorized to reprogram funds
14 appropriated under Section 2 of this Act based on actual expenses incurred for the
15 projects and purposes specified. Such reprogramming shall be limited to reallocating
16 funds among the listed projects to address unforeseen cost adjustments, provided
17 that the total amount appropriated under this Act shall not be exceeded.

18 **Section 4. Authorization for Additional Critical Capital Improvement**
19 **Projects.** Notwithstanding any provision of law, the funds appropriated or
20 authorized by this Act for Capital Improvement Projects may be expended for any
21 other critical Capital Improvement Project not specifically enumerated in this Act,
22 provided that the total expenditure for such unlisted project, in combination with all
23 other expenditures authorized by this Act, does not exceed the aggregate amount
24 appropriated or authorized herein.

25 **Section 5. Reporting Requirements.** The Guam Memorial Hospital
26 Authority shall submit quarterly reports to *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and *I Maga'hågan*
27 *Guåhan* detailing the status of each project funded by this appropriation, including

1 expenditures to date, project timelines, and any challenges encountered. The first
2 report shall be due ninety (90) days after the effective date of this Act, and every
3 ninety (90) days thereafter until all funds are expended.

4 **Section 6. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
5 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
6 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
8 severable.

9 **Section 7. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately upon
10 enactment.
