AN ACT TO AMEND SECTION 1(aa)(3) OF CHAPTER V (EXECUTIVE BRANCH), PUBLIC LAW 38-60, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING THE GUAM FIRE DEPARTMENT TO EXPEND THREE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$300,000) FROM THE DEPARTMENT'S UNEXPENDED APPROPRIATED FUNDS FROM PRIOR FISCAL YEARS FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A TUMON RESCUE BASE.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Section 1(aa)(3) of Chapter V (Executive Branch), Public Law 38-60 (General Appropriations Act of 2026), is *amended*, to read:

“(3) Unexpended Funds from Prior Fiscal Years. Unexpended appropriated funds available to the Guam Fire Department in prior fiscal years shall not lapse and shall be available in Fiscal Year 2026. GFD is authorized to expend the sum of Three Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$300,000) from the department's unexpended appropriated funds from prior fiscal years for the establishment of a Rescue Base in Tumon. Funds shall not be subject to I Maga'hågan Guåhan's transfer authority and shall remain available to GFD until fully expended pursuant to this Act.”

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
