**AN ACT TO AMEND § 84108 OF CHAPTER 84 OF ALL  
OF TITLE 10 RELATIVE TO UPDATING THE  
EMERGENCY MEDICAL COMMISSION  
COMPOSITION (EMS).**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1.** §84108 of Chapter 84, Title 10 GCA is hereby amended to read:

3 **“§ 84108. Composition.**

4 The Commission shall consist of eighteen (18) members of which ~~seventeen~~  
5 ~~sixteen~~(17)(16) members are appointed *by I Maga'lahi/Maga'håga* (the Governor)  
6 and who shall serve at his/her pleasure from each of the following organizations or  
7 groups. Of the eighteen (18) members, eleven (11) are voting members and seven  
8 (7) are non-voting members:

9 (a) two (2) representatives from the Guam Fire Department: one (1)  
10 Emergency Medical Technician (EMT-B), and one (1) ~~EMT-Intermediate~~ Advanced  
11 EMT, or Paramedic certified/licensed to practice within Guam;

12 (b) one representative from the Guam Fire Department E911 Bureau;

13 (c) one (1) representative from the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority:  
14 Emergency Room Nurse or Physician licensed to practice within Guam;

- 1            (d) one (1) representative from the Guam Regional Medical City: Emergency  
2 Nurse or Physician licensed to practice within Guam
- 3            ~~(d)~~ (e) one (1) representative from the Guam Community College School of  
4 Allied Health;
- 5            ~~(e) one (1) representative from the Department of Public Works Office of~~  
6 ~~Highway Safety, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity;~~
- 7            (f) one (1) representative from the Department of Public Health and Social  
8 Services;
- 9            (g) one (1) representative from ~~Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil~~  
10 ~~Defense, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity~~ the Guam Police  
11 Department;
- 12            ~~(h) one (1) representative from Incumbent Local Exchange Carrier~~
- 13            ~~(i) one (1) representative from the Guam Police Department~~
- 14            ~~(j)~~ (h) one (1) representative who is a pediatrician with unlimited medical  
15 license to practice within Guam;
- 16            ~~(k)~~ (i) one (1) physician with unlimited medical license to practice within  
17 Guam engaged in the conduct and delivery of the practice of emergency medical  
18 services;
- 19            ~~(l)~~ (j) one (1) representative from the Guam Department of Education:  
20 Registered Nurse or School Health Counselor;
- 21            (k) one (1) representative from the Department of Public Works Office of  
22 Highway Safety, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity;
- 23            (l) one (1) representative from Guam Homeland Security/Office of Civil  
24 Defense, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity;
- 25            (m) one (1) representative from the Guam Hotel and Restaurant Association,  
26 to serve on the Commission in a non voting capacity;

1           (n) ~~two~~ one (21) additional Commission members shall be selected from the  
2 public-at-large, who ~~are~~ is not directly related to providing emergency medical  
3 services, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity;

4           (o) one (1) representative from the US Naval Hospital; Emergency Room  
5 Nurse or Physician, to serve on the Commission in a non-voting capacity;

6           ~~(p)~~ (p) Appropriate Joint Region of Marianas authorities shall be requested to  
7 designate one (1) EMS representative each to serve on the Commission in a non-  
8 voting capacity; and

9           ~~(q)~~ (q) a member of a non-governmental entity that provides non-emergency  
10 medical transport service and related medical transport services provided in the land,  
11 sea, and air, in accordance with the provisions of this Chapter, to serve on the  
12 Commission in a non-voting capacity.”

13           **Section 2. Severability.** If any of the provisions of this Act or the application  
14 thereof to any person or circumstance are held invalid, such invalidity shall not affect  
15 any other provision or application of this Act, which can be given effect without the  
16 invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
17 severable.
