AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000) FROM THE RAINY DAY FUND TO THE GUAM DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE FOR COMPENSATION TO FARMERS FOR CROP DAMAGE PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 64A OF TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED.

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Appropriation to the Department of Agriculture.**

3 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Two Million Dollars
4 **(\$2,000,000)** is appropriated from the Rainy Day Fund to the Guam Department of
5 Agriculture for the sole purpose of funding the Crop Loss Compensation Program
6 (CLCP).

7 **Section 2. Administration.** Funds appropriated in Section 1 of this Act are
8 not subject to any transfer authority. Notwithstanding any other provision of law,
9 rule, or regulation, the Director of the Guam Department of Agriculture shall provide
10 reports to the Guam Legislature on a monthly basis until all the funds are expended.

11 **Section 3. Transfer of Authority Prohibited.** The funds in this Act shall
12 continue to be available until expended and shall not be subject to any transfer
13 authority of *I Maga'hågan Guåhan*, or any inter-fund borrowing, or for any other
14 purpose.

15 **Section 4. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
16 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not

1 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
2 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
3 severable.

4 **Section 5. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
