AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FIFTY-FIVE THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$55,000.00) FROM THE FUNDS OF THE OFFICE OF SENATOR TELO T. TAITAGUE TO HARVEST HOUSE RESOURCE CENTER TO PROVIDE NEEDED SUPPORT AND SUPPLIES TO FOSTER CHILDREN.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings & intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds that the Harvest House is a nonprofit organization dedicated to serving Guam's foster children, who have endured abuse, abandonment and neglect. The intended funding will provide financial support to the Harvest House Resource Center to stock essential items needed for the proper care of foster children being assisted by Harvest House.

It is the intent of *I Liheslatura* to appropriate Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) from the budget allotted to the Office of Senator Telo T. Taitague to Harvest House.

Section 2. Appropriation: The sum of Fifty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$55,000.00) is hereby appropriated from the budget allotted to the Office of Senator Telo T. Taitague by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to Harvest House for the care of foster

1 children to include providing food, clothing, shoes, hygiene products, and school
2 supplies.

3 Notwithstanding any other law or rule, the Fiscal Officer of *I Liheslatura* is
4 authorized to reduce the allotment to the budget allotted to the Office of Senator Telo
5 T. Taitague by an amount equal to the sum appropriated by this section.

6 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
7 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
8 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
9 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
10 severable.

11 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
