**AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE FOUR MILLION SIX HUNDRED FIFTY-SIX THOUSAND FIVE HUNDRED SIXTY-EIGHT DOLLARS (\$4,656,568) FROM THE GENERAL FUND UNAPPROPRIATED BALANCE AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2025 TO THE WORKER'S COMPENSATION FUND FOR THE WORKERS COMPENSATION COMMISSION TO PAY UNPAID CLAIMS AND/OR VENDOR PAYMENTS FOR FY2024 AND FY2025 AND APPROPRIATE ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR FY2026.**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1. Appropriation for Unpaid Claims and/or Vendor Payments for FY2024 and FY2025.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the sum of Three Million Eight Hundred Fifty-Six Thousand Five Hundred Sixty-Eight Dollars (\$3,856,568) is appropriated from the General Fund unappropriated balance as of September 30, 2025 to the Worker's Compensation Fund for the Workers Compensation Commission to pay unpaid claims and/or vendor payments for Fiscal Years 2024 and 2025.

**Section 2. Supplemental Appropriation to the Department of Labor for Worker's Compensation Fund for FY2026.** Notwithstanding any other provision

1 of law, for Fiscal Year 2026, the sum of Eight Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$800,000)  
2 is appropriated from the General Fund unappropriated balance as of September 30,  
3 2025 to the Worker's Compensation Fund for Worker's Compensation payments  
4 pursuant to § 9144, Chapter 9, Title 22 of the Guam Code Annotated, including  
5 obligations incurred in past years and in the future. Said appropriation may be used  
6 to pay for medical, surgical, and other treatment; nurses; hospital services; medical  
7 travel and per diem costs; medicine; crutches; and equipment required by a claimant  
8 for such period as his injury and the recovery therefrom may require.

9       **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
10 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not  
11 affect other provisions or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are  
12 severable.

13       **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
