**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW SUBSECTION (E) TO § 21103
OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE
ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO WAIVING SANITARY
PERMIT FEES FOR STUDENT-LED FUNDRAISERS.**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Sanitary Permit Fee Waiver for Student-Led Fundraisers.

Subsection (e) is added to § 21103 of Chapter 21, Division 2, Title 10, Guam Code Annotated, to read as follows:

(a) The form of the permit shall be prescribed by the Director. All permits applicable thereto shall be issued on an annual basis and, regardless of when issued, shall expire one (1) year after the date for which issued or renewed.

(b) All permits applicable thereto which are already in existence prior to the enactment of this law shall be renewed on the month consistent with the month they originally attained their permit. The Director shall have up to twelve (12) months from the enactment of this law to amend the renewal dates of these sanitary permits to conform with the renewal date outlined in the Section.

(c) Sanitary permits for the temporary workforce housing category, as defined in Chapter 26A of this Title, shall adhere to the permit renewal schedule pursuant to 10 GCA § 26A104.

(d) The fee for the sanitary permit shall be determined by the Director by regulation and shall be collected by him or his designee. The falsification of an

1 application for a sanitary permit may result in the suspension or revocation of the
2 sanitary permit in accordance with 10 GCA § 21109.

3 (e) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, rule, or regulation, including
4 but not limited to Title 26, Division 1, Chapter 4 of the Guam Administrative Rules
5 and Regulations, no fee shall be required for a sanitary permit issued pursuant to this
6 Chapter for a temporary food service facility operated by a student organization or
7 school group for fundraising purposes. For purposes of this subsection:

8 (1) 'Student organization or school group' means any group affiliated
9 with a public or private elementary, secondary, or postsecondary school on
10 Guam, including but not limited to clubs, sports teams, or class councils;

11 (2) The event shall not exceed three (3) consecutive days in duration
12 and shall comply with all inspection and sanitation standards under 10 GCA
13 Chapter 21; and

14 (3) The applicant shall submit a certification from the school
15 administrator verifying the fundraising purpose. DPHSS shall adopt
16 implementing rules within ninety (90) days of enactment to facilitate this
17 exemption.

18 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
19 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity shall
20 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
21 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the provisions
22 of this Act are severable.

23 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment
