AN ACT TO APPROPRIATE NO MORE THAN ONE MILLION DOLLARS (\$1,000,000) FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2025 GENERAL FUND REVENUES COLLECTED IN EXCESS OF THE ADOPTED LEVELS ENUMERATED IN PUBLIC LAW 37-125 TO THE HÅGAT MAYOR'S OFFICE FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE REVITALIZATION AND RENOVATION OF THE FORMER HÅGAT FIRE STATION AND POLICE STATION FOR THE PURPOSE OF THE CREATION OF THE HÅGAT MULTI-PURPOSE FACILITY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent. *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*

acknowledges that the former *Hågat* fire station and police station ceased operations in 2010 with the establishment of a new fire station facility serving both *Hågat* and Santa Rita. This historic structure, which once served as a vital hub for public safety, housed the commissioner's office, a dispensary, and personnel from both the fire and police departments under the former Department of Public Safety.

Since its closure, the building has remained vacant and has fallen into a state of despair due to a lack of consistent maintenance. Thus, it is the intent of the *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* to utilize this building for the benefit of the community. The appropriation of no more than One Million Dollars (\$1,000,000) will be utilized to revitalize and renovate this building into a multi-purpose facility. This facility may be utilized as, but is not limited to, a community center, a disaster relief supply center

1 and a postal service office, providing valuable resources and services to the residents
2 of *Hågat*.

3 **Section 2. Appropriation to the *Hågat* Mayor’s Office.** Notwithstanding
4 any other provision of law, the sum of no more than One Million Dollars
5 (\$1,000,000) from the Fiscal Year 2025 General Fund Revenues collected in excess
6 of the adopted levels enumerated in Public Law 37-125 is hereby appropriated to the
7 *Hågat* Mayor’s Office for the purpose of revitalization and renovation of the former
8 *Hågat* Fire Station and Police Station for the purposes of the creation of a *Hågat*
9 multi-purpose facility. This facility may be utilized as, but is not limited to, a
10 community center, a disaster relief supply center and a postal service office. Upon
11 the completion of the revitalization and renovation project, the unexpended and
12 unused appropriation shall revert back to the General Fund.

13 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to
14 any person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall
15 not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
16 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
17 severable.

18 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
