AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 85A103.1 TO CHAPTER 85A, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ALLOWING THE GUAM COUNCIL OF ARTS AND HUMANITIES AGENCY TO GRANT EIGHT (8) MASTER AWARDS FOR AWARD YEARS 2018 AND 2022 WHEN THE AGENCY WAS UNABLE TO MAKE THE FOUR (4) AWARDS ALLOTTED FOR EACH OF SAID YEARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. A new § 85A103.1 is *added* to Chapter 85A, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated to read as follows:

“§ 85A103.1 Master Awards for Years 2018 and 2022.

Notwithstanding the provisions of § 85A103, 5 GCA; up until December 31, 2025, The Guam Council of the Arts and Humanities Agency may accept nominations, select and present no more than eight (8) Master Awards to account for award years 2018 and 2022.”
