1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, International Women's Day, observed annually on March 8, is a
4 global celebration recognizing the achievements of women, while also serving as a
5 reminder of the continuing work needed to ensure greater gender parity and
6 opportunities for women and girls in every community. This year, International
7 Women's Day celebrates 115 years of collective action across the world for their
8 progress towards gender equality; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the International Women's Club of Guam has played an important
10 role in the island community by bringing together women of diverse nationalities,
11 cultures, and backgrounds in a spirit of friendship and shared purpose; and

12 **WHEREAS**, since its founding, the International Women's Club of Guam has

14 meaningful connections among residents of Guam and the international community
15 through fellowship, service projects, charitable activities, and cultural exchange; and

3 educational programs, and community initiatives that benefit women, children, and
4 families throughout Guam; and

5 **WHEREAS**, through its commitment to uniting women of diverse countries
6 and backgrounds in Guam, the International Women’s Club of Guam exemplifies the
7 values of International Women’s Day, demonstrating that women working together
8 strengthen communities and promote harmony among all people; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the leadership, dedication, and generosity of the International
10 Women’s Club of Guam continue to inspire others to participate in acts of service,
11 cultural exchange, and civic engagement for the betterment of the island and its people
12 now therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*
14 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
15 of Guam, recognize and commend the International Women’s Club of Guam for its
