1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF I**
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Storm Pablo, born Manuel San Agustin Pablo II on Guam in 1991,
4 is the son of Manuel and Mary Jean Pablo and is one of three children; and

5 **WHEREAS**, Storm was raised in Ypaopao Estates in Dededo and attended Maria
6 A. Ulloa Elementary School before leaving island with his family when he was 11 years
7 old; and

8 **WHEREAS**, from an early age, Storm exhibited a strong desire to express
9 himself through fashion, inspired by his mother's influence and their shared experiences
10 working in retail environments, which nurtured his passion for clothing and personal
11 style; and

12 **WHEREAS**, despite frequent relocations and challenges in establishing roots,
13 Storm's dedication to fashion flourished, drawing from diverse influences including
14 icons such as Kurt Cobain and Dennis Rodman, and culminating in his eventual move
15 to Seattle for high school and later to Los Angeles to pursue his dreams; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Storm’s journey into styling began organically through retail and
2 showroom work, where his initiative and talent led to opportunities to coordinate and
3 style for prominent musicians and celebrities, notably becoming the stylist for
4 acclaimed artist Bad Bunny, whose collaboration proved pivotal for both their careers;
5 and

6 **WHEREAS**, Storm’s professional achievements also include the founding of
7 CNTRA, a clothing brand rooted in the values of self-expression, resilience, and
8 camaraderie, which he co-created with trusted friends, and which continues to inspire
9 through its message and design; and

10 **WHEREAS**, through his work with artists such as Bad Bunny, Jack Harlow,
11 Young Miko, and SiR, as well as his commitment to creative growth and mentoring
12 others, Pablo has made a lasting impact on the fashion industry, promoting inclusivity
13 and innovation; now therefore, be it

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*
15 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
16 of Guam, recognize Storm Pablo for his achievements, vision and contributions to the
17 art and industry of fashion; and further commends his creative leadership and
18 commitment to excellence demonstrated by his remarkable work and influence
19 throughout his distinguished career; and be it further
