3 **WHEREAS**, Jerrold “Jere” C. Johnson, born on March 3, 1950, in San Rafael,
4 California, earned a Bachelor of Science in Civil Engineering from the University of
5 California, Berkeley, and furthered his professional development through advanced
6 studies and executive training at the University of Hawai‘i; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Mr. Johnson dedicated over five decades to the construction
8 industry, rising through the ranks from Construction Engineer to President, including
9 executive leadership roles with Hawaiian Dredging and Hawaiian Rock Products; and

10 **WHEREAS**, as President of Hawaiian Rock Products, Mr. Johnson built a
11 remarkable legacy of leadership, guiding one of Guam’s most critical construction
12 materials companies through decades of growth, modernization, and reliability,
13 ensuring the steady supply of essential materials that underpin the island’s
14 infrastructure, economic expansion, and military and civilian development; and

1 **WHEREAS**, under his stewardship, Hawaiian Rock Products became
2 synonymous with quality, operational excellence, and industry leadership, playing an
3 indispensable role in shaping the physical and economic landscape of Guam; and

4 **WHEREAS**, his professional excellence was recognized through numerous
5 honors, including being named Guam Business News Executive of the Year in 2012
6 and as one of the Pacific Jaycees' Outstanding Young People of Guam in 1988; and

7 **WHEREAS**, beyond his professional achievements, Mr. Johnson has
8 demonstrated steadfast commitment to community service through leadership roles in
9 the Guam Contractors Association, the Guam Chamber of Commerce, the Rotary Club
10 of Tumon Bay, the Society of Military Engineers, the Navy League of the United States,
11 the St. John's School Board of Trustees, the Andersen Civilian Advisory Council, and
12 the Guam Workforce Development Board; and

13 **WHEREAS**, through these contributions, Mr. Johnson has helped shape Guam's
14 workforce, strengthen civic institutions, and mentor future generations of leaders in
15 both industry and community service; and

16 **WHEREAS**, alongside his professional achievements, the support and
17 partnership of his wife, Darleen Sumie Johnson, have been integral to a shared life of
18 service to the community; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Darleen Sumie Johnson, born on May 14, 1953, in Hilo, Hawai'i,
20 is a graduate of Chaminade University, where she pursued studies in marketing, and is
21 a successful business owner in Guam; and

22 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Johnson has demonstrated a deep and sustained commitment
23 to community service through her involvement with organizations such as the Guam
24 American Red Cross and her leadership in numerous fundraising efforts supporting St.
25 John's School, the University of Guam's 60th Anniversary initiatives, Central East
26 Little League, and the Tumon Soccer Club; and

27 **WHEREAS**, her leadership as a past Board Chairman and fundraising chair has
28 strengthened community programs, supported youth development, and enhanced
29 charitable initiatives across Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, together, Jerrold and Darleen Johnson exemplify a lifetime of
2 service, leadership, and dedication to the betterment of Guam through both professional
3 excellence and community involvement; now therefore, be it

4 **RESOLVED**, that *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on
5 behalf of the people of Guam, recognize and commend Jerrold “Jere” C. Johnson on his
6 retirement and thank him for his outstanding contributions to Guam’s development and
