3 **WHEREAS**, Mrs. Susan Pimentel-Unpingco has called our island home, where
4 she has fulfilled in the enrichment of her personal and professional life. She is the
5 daughter of the late Unvencion Fallejo and Aurora Martinez Pimental. She is married
6 to Mark Unpingco and they have six (6) children: Shannon and Tim Taijeron; Savannah;
