1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÁHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS, †Mr. Juan Guerrero Camacho, Familian “Flight” of Santa Rita -**
4 **Sumai, affectionately known at Mount Carmel School as “Mr. C,” devoted nearly two**
5 **decades of exemplary service to the Mount Carmel School community, faithfully**
6 **serving its students, faculty, staff, and families with countless hours of unwavering**
7 **commitment, professionalism, trust, and security; and**

8 **WHEREAS, †“Mr. C” began his service at Mount Carmel School as an active**
9 **parent and volunteer, then as the head Physical Education teacher, basketball and**
10 **volleyball coach, Athletic Director, and later served with distinction as Vice Principal**
11 **for Discipline and in his most recent position as Facilities and Maintenance Manager,**
12 **carrying out each responsibility with steadfast leadership, success, and deep care for the**
13 **school community; and**

1 **WHEREAS**, throughout his years at Mount Carmel School, †“Mr. C” dedicated
2 himself not only to the academic success of students, but also to their personal growth,
3 discipline, character, and well-being, becoming a mentor and father figure to many
4 students who looked to him for guidance, encouragement, and support; and

5 **WHEREAS** †Mr. C” possessed a strong work ethic and an unmatched sense of
6 responsibility, often being among the first to arrive and the last to leave campus, always
7 ensuring that the school grounds, facilities, and daily operations were prepared and
8 maintained for the safety and success of the entire MCS Familia; and

9 **WHEREAS**, prior to his years at Mount Carmel School, †“Mr. C” honorably
10 served in the United States Marine Corps, serving with distinction and retiring as
11 Sergeant Major, a rank achieved by less than one percent of all enlisted Marines,
12 representing the pinnacle of enlisted service and exemplifying throughout his life the
13 values of discipline, leadership, honor, sacrifice, and service to others; and

14 **WHEREAS** †“Mr. C” consistently demonstrated his CHamoru culture, integrity,
15 humility, respect, and compassion in his daily interactions with students, faculty, staff,
16 parents, and the greater community, serving as a role model whose quiet strength and
17 steady leadership positively influenced and changed countless lives; and

18 **WHEREAS**, in overseeing school discipline, facilities, and campus operations,
19 †Mr. Camacho became known as one of the hardest working and most trusted members
20 of the MCS Familia, tirelessly ensuring that Mount Carmel School remained a safe,
21 functional, welcoming, and nurturing environment where students and educators could
22 thrive together and create lasting memories; and

23 **WHEREAS** †“Mr. C” became known throughout the school community for his
24 familiar reminder that there are “a lotta moving parts,” a phrase that reflected his
25 practical wisdom, calm leadership, steady presence, and belief in teamwork,
26 accountability, perseverance, and unity; and

1 **WHEREAS**, beyond his titles and responsibilities, †“Mr. C” was a loyal friend,
2 respected mentor, proud CHamoru son of Guam, devoted husband, loving father, and
3 servant leader whose kindness, humor, wisdom, and compassion touched the hearts of
4 generations of students, families, colleagues, and community members; and

5 **WHEREAS**, through his decades of service, †“Mr. C” leaves behind a lasting
6 and meaningful legacy upon Mount Carmel School and the people of Guam through his
7 unmatched loyalty, dedication to education, commitment to service, and unwavering
8 belief in the potential of every student entrusted to his care; now therefore, be it

9 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*
10 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people
11 of Guam, posthumously recognize †Juan Guerrero Camacho who will always be
12 remembered as a pillar and a true leader of Mount Carmel School and to the people of
13 Guam; and be it further

14 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
15 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of
