Relative to recognizing and commending the Filipino Community of Guam for its community beautification initiative and bench installation project at the Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park.

1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:**

3 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Community of Guam has long contributed to the social,
4 cultural, civic, and charitable life of Guam through volunteerism, public service, and
5 community engagement benefiting the people of Guam; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Community of Guam has initiated a community
7 beautification project involving the installation of precast concrete benches at the
8 Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park; and

9 **WHEREAS**, the project includes the installation of thirty-six (36) precast
10 concrete benches in front of the amphitheater area of the Governor Joseph Flores
11 Memorial Park to provide additional seating and accessibility for park patrons and
12 community members; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park remains one of Guam's
14 most frequented public recreational spaces, serving residents, families, visitors, cultural
15 organizations, students, and community groups throughout the island; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the installation of additional public seating is intended to improve
17 accessibility, comfort, convenience, and the overall experience of individuals and

1 families utilizing the park for recreation, exercise, gatherings, and community events;
2 and

3 **WHEREAS**, community-driven improvement projects such as this demonstrate
4 civic pride, volunteerism, and a shared commitment to preserving and enhancing
5 Guam’s public spaces for present and future generations; and

6 **WHEREAS**, the people of Guam benefit greatly from partnerships between
7 nonprofit organizations, cultural organizations, community groups, and government
8 agencies that work collaboratively to strengthen and beautify public recreational
9 facilities throughout the island; and

10 **WHEREAS**, the Filipino Community of Guam’s bench installation initiative
11 reflects the spirit of *inafa’maolek* through collective action, stewardship, and service
12 to the community; now therefore, be it

13 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina’trentai Ocho Na Liheslaturan*
14 *Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the people of Guam,
15 recognize and commend the Filipino Community of Guam for its community beautification
16 initiative and bench installation project at the Governor Joseph Flores Memorial Park; and
17 be it further

18 **RESOLVED**, that the Speaker and the Chairperson of the Committee on Rules
19 certify, and the Legislative Secretary attest to, the adoption hereof, and that copies of the
20 same be thereafter transmitted to the Filipino Community of Guam; the Department of
21 Parks and Recreation; and the Honorable Lourdes A. Leon Guerrero, *I Maga’hågan*
22 *Guåhan*.
