3 **WHEREAS**, the Chinese Ladies Association of Guam (CLAG) was established
4 in May 1995 and has, for more than thirty-one (31) years, served as a respected
5 charitable and civic organization committed to strengthening the island community
6 through volunteerism, cultural outreach, and humanitarian efforts; and

7 **WHEREAS**, throughout its history, CLAG has fostered friendship, unity, and
8 cultural understanding among the people of Guam by bringing together women and
9 families from diverse backgrounds in the spirit of service and community collaboration;

11 **WHEREAS**, CLAG has consistently supported charitable causes and nonprofit
12 organizations through fundraising initiatives, cultural programs, donations, volunteer
13 activities, and community events that benefit residents across Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, organizations and causes supported by CLAG over the years
2 include educational institutions, healthcare initiatives, senior care services, cultural
3 preservation programs, disaster relief efforts, and community-based nonprofit
4 organizations dedicated to improving the quality of life on Guam; and

5 **WHEREAS**, CLAG has contributed to organizations and initiatives including
6 the Chinese School of Guam, the Guam Memorial Hospital Volunteer Association,
7 community health and senior assistance programs, cultural and educational outreach
8 efforts, and humanitarian relief activities benefiting local and regional communities;

10 **WHEREAS**, CLAG continues to promote and preserve Chinese culture and
11 traditions through educational programs, cultural performances, public events, and
12 activities that celebrate Guam’s rich multicultural diversity and strengthen community
13 ties; and

14 **WHEREAS**, proceeds from CLAG’s fundraising activities continue to support
15 organizations and programs that provide educational opportunities, healthcare
16 assistance, cultural enrichment, senior support services, and humanitarian aid
17 throughout Guam and the region; and

18 **WHEREAS**, the Chinese Ladies Association of Guam remains a shining
19 example of compassion, generosity, cultural pride, and civic responsibility, reflecting
20 the enduring spirit of service that continues to positively impact the island community;
21 now therefore, be it
