13 **WHEREAS**, Ricardo's remarkable longevity, having reached ninety-seven (97)
14 years of age, and Maria's unwavering dedication to family, business, and community,
15 stand as testaments to their strength of character and vitality; and

16 **WHEREAS**, the Quiambao family's legacy extends beyond their immediate
17 relatives, touching the lives of countless individuals through business, charity, and
18 friendship, earning the respect and admiration of the people of Guam; and

19 **WHEREAS**, Ricardo and Maria's marriage, spanning seventy (70) years, serves
20 as an inspiration to couples and families throughout the island, demonstrating the
21 virtues of perseverance, love, and unity in the face of life's challenges; now therefore,
