Relative to recognizing the Philippine National Bank Guam on the Occasion of its Thirteenth Anniversary and for its contributions to the people of Guam, the Filipino Community, and the island's economic development.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN*:

WHEREAS, the Philippine National Bank (PNB) Guam will commemorate thirteen (13) years of service on September 9, 2026, marking the anniversary of the inauguration of its Micronesia Mall Branch in 2013; and

WHEREAS, the establishment of the Micronesia Mall Branch expanded PNB's presence in Guam and strengthened access to banking services for residents, families, and businesses, particularly within the island's Filipino community; and

WHEREAS, PNB Guam has provided a range of financial services throughout its thirteen years, including remittances, consumer and commercial banking, business lending, deposits, and other financial services connecting customers in Guam with the Philippines; and

WHEREAS, recognizing the changing needs of its customers, PNB Guam has continued to expand its consumer and commercial banking services while embracing

1 digital banking technologies that provide greater convenience, accessibility, and
2 security; and

3 **WHEREAS**, PNB Guam has served as a financial bridge between Guam and the
4 Philippines, helping families maintain connections across borders while providing
5 entrepreneurs and businesses with financial resources to support their goals and growth;

7 **WHEREAS**, PNB Guam's distinctive strength lies in combining PNB's
8 established international banking network with a local understanding of the
9 communities it serves, allowing it to provide personalized financial services while
10 facilitating access to banking resources in both Guam and the Philippines; and

11 **WHEREAS**, the institution's thirteen-year presence in Guam reflects the
12 dedication of its employees and leadership, whose commitment to integrity,
13 accountability, teamwork, and customer service has helped establish lasting
14 relationships with customers and community partners; and

15 **WHEREAS**, under the leadership of General Manager and Branch Head Roldan
16 P. Dela Fuente, PNB Guam continues to pursue opportunities for growth and innovation
17 while remaining responsive to the evolving needs of Guam's families, businesses, and
18 financial sector; and

19 **WHEREAS**, PNB Guam has also demonstrated its commitment to the
20 community through its participation in community events, outreach efforts, financial
21 literacy initiatives, and programs that support the Filipino community and contribute to
22 Guam's economic vitality; and

23 **WHEREAS**, *I Liheslaturan Guahan* recognizes the important role that trusted
24 financial institutions play in strengthening families, supporting local enterprise,
25 facilitating economic activity, and maintaining the longstanding ties between Guam
