1           **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***  
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3           **WHEREAS**, originally known as the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam (FPCG),  
4 the Filipino American Presidents Club of Guam (FAPCG) was chartered in 1984 with  
5 the purpose and objectives of fostering unity and closer relationship among members  
6 for a common ideal and vision for peace as primary goal to bring about a vibrant  
7 community, to assist people of Guam and abroad in time of need by providing moral  
8 and financial support, to provide socio-civic, spiritual and humanitarian support to all  
9 members and the community and to participate in all activities and functions and to  
10 generate revenues in accordance with the laws of the Territory of Guam and the United  
11 States of America; and

1           **WHEREAS**, in 1985, the late Senator Ernesto Espaldon assumed the task of  
2 resurrecting and revitalizing the Filipino Community of Guam (FCG) as one of the  
3 prominent accomplishments of the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam (FPCG); and

4           **WHEREAS**, in 1996 during the inaugural speech of first Chairwoman Lynda  
5 Tolan, she announced her two main goals for the organization. First is creating an  
6 annual signature project, the Scholarship Program and the second is the updating of the  
7 club’s name from the Filipino Presidents Club of Guam to the Filipino-American  
8 President Club of Guam with the concurrence by the Board of Governors; and

9           **WHEREAS**, in the past 42 years, FAPCG had supported with monetary  
10 donations to the following charitable organizations: American Cancer Society,  
11 American Red Cross, Lytico & Bodig, Carmelite Sisters, Guam Museum Foundation,  
12 St. Dominic Senior Care Home, Archbishop Felixberto Flores memorial statue, FCG  
13 Leyte Mudslide Fund, Blindness Foundation in the Philippines, Hurricane Katrina  
14 Fund, to Philippines’ several typhoon victims. The club also supported the Filipino  
15 Ladies Association of Guam’s cultural event, the Santacruzán and the Filipino  
16 Community of Guam’s activities and donations to the Catholic churches’ Misa d Gallo  
17 during Christmas season; and

18           **WHEREAS**, The Filipino-American Presidents Club of Guam is composed of  
19 past and present presidents and vice presidents of different Filipino-American ethnic  
20 and international organizations while sustaining members are open to any Filipino  
21 American who is ready to subscribe to the goals and objectives of the club. Executive  
22 officers are elected every two years in October and are inducted into office in January  
23 of the following year; and

24           **WHEREAS**, the FAPCG’s 2024-2025 outgoing Executive Officers are Susan  
25 Ibit, Chairwoman; Blanca Imbo, Vice-Chairwoman; Cynthia Nisay, Treasurer; Chito

1 De Guzman-Aguilo, Secretary; Lynda A. Tolan, Auditor; Chona Cabedo-Garin, Public  
2 Relations Officer and Lorie Castelo, Peace Officer; and

3 **WHEREAS**, the FAPCG’s 2026-2027 incoming Executive Officers are Blanca  
4 Imbo, Chairwoman; Cynthia Nisay, Vice Chairwoman; Ferna De La Pena, Secretary;  
5 Amafel Silvestre, Assistant Secretary; Lesly Dayson, Treasurer; Gloria Baguion,  
6 Assistant Treasurer; Chona Cabedo-Garin, Public Relations Officer; Demetria  
7 Robinson, Auditor; Lorie Castelo and Shirley Trinidad, Peace Officers; and

8 **WHEREAS**, under outgoing Chairwoman Susan Ibit’s leadership this past year,  
9 the FAPCG’s accomplishments include the annual continuing scholarship grants to  
10 University of Guam students; the annual humanitarian project during Thanksgiving &  
11 Christmas season feeding the Hungry/Homeless people at former Kamalen  
12 Karidat/Archdiocese of Hagåtña Ministry of the Homeless; monetary donations to the  
13 Eskwelahang Munti; the presentation of \$700 donations to the Filipino Community of  
14 Guam Typhoon Fund Drive for the victims of Philippines two typhoons; and the  
15 fellowship and celebration among members on President’s Day, Father’s Day, Mother’s  
16 Day and Thanksgiving/Christmas day; now therefore be it

17 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*  
18 *Lihe slaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihe slaturan Guåhan* and the people
