1 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COMMITTEE ON RULES OF *I***
2 ***MINA'TRENTAI OCHO NA LIHESLATURAN GUÅHAN:***

3 **WHEREAS**, Marietta P. Vicente, affectionately known as “Mayette,” is
4 originally from San Jose City, Nueva Ecija, Philippines, and has made Guam her home
5 for forty-four (44) years, residing in the village of Yigo and contributing to the
6 community she proudly serves; and

7 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Vicente is the daughter of the late Lilia Paez and Rosalino
8 Paez, and her life of service has been strengthened by the steadfast support of her
9 family—her husband Arnoll M. Vicente and her children Nicollette V. Velasco and
10 Neal Keanu P. Vicente—who have shared in and supported her commitment throughout
11 her career; and

12 **WHEREAS**, on February 8, 1993, Ms. Vicente began her career in public service
13 with the Guam Waterworks Authority when it operated as the Public Utility Agency of
14 Guam (PUAG), embarking on a calling marked by diligence, integrity, and an
15 unwavering sense of duty to the people of Guam; and

1 **WHEREAS**, Ms. Vicente served with distinction in the Finance Division, first
2 as Payroll Clerk II and later as Payroll Supervisor, where she safeguarded one of the
3 Authority’s most essential responsibilities by ensuring the timely and accurate
4 compensation of employees—work that demanded precision, confidentiality, and
5 consistent excellence; and

6 **WHEREAS**, as the Authority evolved, Ms. Vicente remained a steady and
7 trusted force through major organizational and system transitions, providing continuity
8 and confidence for management and staff alike; and

9 **WHEREAS**, among her most significant contributions, Ms. Vicente played a key
10 role in the implementation and transition of multiple payroll system upgrades, including
11 migration to JD Edwards World and JD Edwards EnterpriseOne, helping modernize
12 payroll operations and strengthening efficiency, accuracy, and accountability; and

13 **WHEREAS**, over the course of thirty-three (33) years of faithful service, Ms.
14 Vicente’s professionalism, deep institutional knowledge, and exceptional work ethic
15 earned the respect of her colleagues and leadership, and her quiet reliability helped
16 sustain the Guam Waterworks Authority’s stability and mission for more than three
17 decades; and

18 **WHEREAS**, after a long and honorable career devoted to public service, Ms.
19 Vicente retires effective March 6, 2026, and looks forward to traveling and spending
20 quality time with her family, confident that she leaves behind a legacy of excellence,
21 dedication, and enduring public trust; now therefore, be it

22 **RESOLVED**, that the Committee on Rules of *I Mina'trentai Ocho Na*
23 *Lihselaturan Guåhan* does hereby, on behalf of *I Lihselaturan Guåhan* and the people
24 of Guam, commend and congratulate Marietta P. Vicente upon her retirement from the
