1/ Although the proposed legislation appears administrative in nature, there may be a cost impact should the GDOE decide to contract a third-party consulting firm to conduct the classification, compensation, and benefit structure study. The Bureau is unable to determine any anticipated cost impacts absent information from the GDOE. It should be noted that a request for comments was sent to the GDOE on August 28, 2026, but no responses have been provided as of the preparation of this fiscal note.
