The Bureau requests that Bill No. 280-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 280-38 (COR) is an act to amend § 52.10 of Chapter 52 of Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, to add a new § 52.70 to Chapter 52 of Title 9 Guam Code Annotated, relative to prohibiting interfering with a Judicial Officer; and to add a new § 55.70 to Chapter 55 of Title 9, Guam Code Annotated, relative to prohibiting interfering with a Peace Officer, in the interest of public safety.

Based on comments received, the Unified Judiciary of Guam has stated that the bill is administrative in nature and there is no anticipated fiscal impact to the branch at this time.

The Bureau has also determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of the Government of Guam.
