Hafa Adai! Vice Speaker Ada:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 284-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 284-38 (COR) is an act to amend Section 18 of Part I, Chapter II, Public Law 38-60, relative to the Guam Department of Education (GDOE) Continuing Appropriation Authorization.

The proposed Bill 284-38 changes the current language of Section 18 relative to the authorized uses of the funds available appropriated to GDOE through Public Law 37-125 under the continuing appropriation authorization provision for Fiscal Year 2026. The proposed language will authorize the continuing appropriation to be used for capital improvement projects, including but not limited to, GDOE school sports facilities and playgrounds, and instructional equipment. Please note that according to comments received, the GDOE recommends additional changes to the proposed language to encompass all "unexpended funds available to the GDOE in prior fiscal years" and to add campus security as an authorize use of the continuing appropriation. The proposed language changes by the GDOE will cause an additional fiscal impact if prior fiscal year unexpended balances are included.

As introduced, the Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of the Government of Guam.
