
Hafa adai, Vice Speaker Ada:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 308-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 308-38 (COR) is an act to add a new § 121202(b)(1), Guam Code Annotated, relative to regulating the training of clinical psychologists to allow for supervision in Guam. The proposed legislation intends to establish a clear framework for training of post-doctorate interns of clinical psychology under the Guam Board of Allied Health Examiners (GBAHE) by adding Article 12, Chapter 12, Guam Code Annotated, to define who can supervise these interns.

Per correspondence with the Department of Public Health and Social Services (DPHSS), the proposed amendments will have no fiscal impact on its current administrative operations as the regulatory framework will be managed within the existing operational capacity and administrative functions of the GBAHE. As such, this bill is administrative and regulatory in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
