Hafa Adai, Vice Speaker Ada:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 311-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 311-38 is an act to appropriate \$2M from the Rainy-Day Fund to the Guam Department of Agriculture for compensation to farmers for crop damage pursuant to Chapter 64A of Title 5, Guam Code Annotated.

On April 12, 2026, P.L. 38-124 was signed into law which appropriated \$25M to *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* for the emergency response to Tropical Storm *Sinlaku* (later upgraded to Typhoon). This appropriation was comprised of \$7.1M from the unused appropriations to the Department of Public Health and Social Services pursuant to P.L. 38-75 and \$17.9M from the Rainy-Day Fund. On May 1, 2026, the Acting Governor of Guam, Joshua F. Tenorio, authorized \$2M from these funds to be used by the Guam Department of Agriculture for Crop Loss Compensation Payments to Farmers. Because the directives of the Acting Governor fulfilled the intent of Bill No. 311-38, the proposed legislation is no longer required and thereby the Bureau submits this waiver for fiscal comment.
