The Bureau requests that Bill No. 316-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 316-38 is an act to repeal and reenact §8602 (d) of Article 6, Chapter 8, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, relative to facilitating Guam's transition to 100% renewable energy by including the Guam Power Authority (GPA) and Limited Cooperative Associations (LCA) in the Virtual Power Plant Program (VPPP).

The intent of the Bill is to expand the definition of "developer" to include the GPA and LCA to facilitate the implementation of the VPPP in order to transition to 100% renewable energy. Because the re-defining of the term "developer" is the extent of the actions requested by the Bill, the proposed legislation is administrative in nature and poses no fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
