Hafa Adai! Vice Speaker Ada:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 350-38 (LS) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229, as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 350-38 (LS) is an act to add a new Chapter 57 to Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, relative to establishing the "Guam Head Start Standards Act", to preserve minimum quality standards for Head Start and Early Head Start programs operating within Guam, to establish a process for reviewing future Federal standards, and to provide for the adoption of enhanced standards consistent with Federal law.

Please note that the Bureau had sought input on the financial impact of the proposed Bill No. 350-38 from the GDOE on August 20, 2026 with a follow-up request on August 26, 2026. The Bureau has not received any official comments as of the date of this fiscal note waiver.

Based on our review of the proposed legislation, the Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any of the funds of the Government of Guam.
