The Bureau requests that Bill No. 46-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Bill No. 46-38 (COR) is an act to add a new §85A103.1 to Chapter 85A, Title 5 Guam Code Annotated, relative to the Guam Masters Award under the Guam Council on the Arts and Humanities Agency (CAHA). The proposed legislation intends to allow CAHA, up until December 31, 2025, to accept nominations, select, and present no more than eight Guam Master Awards to account for award years 2018 and 2022. According to comments received from CAHA for a similar proposed legislation in the 37th Guam Legislature, Bill No. 383-37 (COR), there is no fiscal impact should this legislation pass.

The Bureau has determined that the Bill is administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam.
