Hafa Adai! Vice Speaker Ada:

The Bureau requests that Bill No. 74-38 (COR) be granted a waiver pursuant to Public Law 12-229 as amended for the following reason(s):

Legislative Bill No. 74-38 (COR) intends to add a new §8125 to Article 1, to add a new §8505(c) to Article 5, to amend §§ 8502(c)(2) and 8505(b)(3) of Article 5; and repeal §8506 of Article 5, all of Chapter 8, Title 12, Guam Code Annotated, relative to net metering and the operations of the Guam Power Authority (GPA). This legislation requires that the GPA submit an annual cost analysis report no later than sixty (60) days following the end of each fiscal year. Among other reporting requirements, the aforementioned report would include compensation for excess energy to the grid by net metering customers.

The proposed amendments are administrative in nature and poses no additional fiscal impact upon any funds of the Government of Guam in FY 2025.
