**AN ACT TO *AMEND* §31101. OF CHAPTER 31, DIVISION  
4, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE  
TO THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF  
TRUSTEES COMPOSITION TO ENHANCE BUSINESS  
AND INDUSTRY REPRESENTATION**

**BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

**Section 1.** §31101. of Chapter 31, Title 17, Guam Code Annotated, is hereby  
amended, to read:

**“§31101. Administration of the Guam Community College.**

(a) All powers vested in the Guam Community College, except as provided  
herein shall be exercised by the Guam Community College Board of Trustees. The  
Board shall consist of seven (7) trustees, six (6) of whom shall be nominated and  
appointed by *I Maga'lahaen Guåhan* with the advice and consent of *I Liheslaturan*  
*Guåhan*. Three (3) trustees shall be appointed to terms of three (3) years, three (3)  
trustees shall be appointed to terms of five (5) years and the seventh (7th) shall be  
an elected student member who shall serve a term of one (1) year. Their successors  
shall be appointed each for a term of five (5) years, with the exception of the student  
member. The student member shall be elected by a plurality vote of students of the  
school. The student member must be a student at the college and may be re-elected  
to no more than one (1) successive one-year term The procedures for election of the

1 student member shall be developed by the Board of Trustees. The first election for  
2 student member shall take place during the school year 1999-2000. The student  
3 member position shall not require the appointment by *I Maga'lahaen Guahan* and the  
4 advice and consent of *I Liheslaturan Guahan*. No courtesy resignations shall be  
5 required. All vacancies occurring on the Board of Trustees, except the student  
6 member, shall be filled by *I Maga'lahaen Guahan* with the advice and consent of *I*  
7 *Liheslaturan Guahan* for the unexpired term.

8 (b) *I Maga'lahaen Guahan* shall appoint ~~one (1) trustee~~ two (2) trustees to  
9 represent business and industry and employer organizations; ~~one (1) trustee to~~  
10 ~~represent organized labor organizations on Island.~~ The remaining four (4) trustees  
11 shall be members of the general public. As these positions on the Board become  
12 vacant, they shall be filled in a like manner. No person may serve as a trustee if the  
13 trustee is a government of Guam employee or if the trustee's service would amount  
14 to a conflict of interest.

15 (c) The concurrence of four (4) members of the Board at a duly called and  
16 noticed regular or special meeting of the Board, which is open to the public in  
17 accordance with law, shall be necessary to the validity of its acts; provided, that the  
18 Board need not meet in public when it is discussing litigation or impending litigation  
19 with its attorney.

20 (d) The trustees shall elect the chairperson from among their number.

21 **Section 2. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any  
22 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or contrary to law, such invalidity  
23 shall not affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect  
24 without the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of the  
25 provisions of this Act are severable.

26 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act shall become effective upon enactment.
