Center. The intent this time is to promote the villages themselves during the tournaments.

"We'd love to partner with you and utilize your facilities this summer. The idea is to take this to a different gym every weekend and have an all-day affair with the kids at your village. This is a low-burden, high-impact partnership," Sablan said.

The start date for the kids' league is set for June 13, and it is expected to end the last week of August before school begins. Aiming to finalize details before the first week of May, Sablan said Clutch will reach out to the village directly for further communication and logistics.

Men's basketball league

Clutch Guam's second summer program is a village-based men's basketball league. Sablan said this program would start earlier in the year and lead into the kids' league.

"We're looking to start as early as April and end the first week of June. It's basically the same ask [but] this one won't be free," Sablan said. "Teams are used to paying entrance fees, but I would suspect since it is a village-based league that

teams' POCs would reach out to mayors' office for funding support."

Sablan said the cost is about \$1,500 per team.

"If we get all 19 villages to participate, it's going to be a highly competitive league, and this is an opportunity for all the younger kids to see and hopefully participate in the sports [later on]," Sablan said.

Malessor Mayor Franklin Champaco asked Sablan if Clutch would ask for residence verification at the tournament "because cubs

like to stack their teams."

Sablan said it could get dicey depending on how many kids enter. He suggested that club coaches may compete with the blessing of a respective village mayor to compete at a particular event.

"We've run this program before. Last year, we had over a thousand kids, so it's going to be very hard for us to verify each and every kid," Sablan said. "It's going to be very hard for us to enforce that rule. I'd like for it to be that way, but if the mayors' offices are somehow able to provide a verification, we can take a look at it and see if it could be a better way to implement."

Yona Mayor Brian Terlaje asked if Clutch would set a quota or threshold for participants per village, "just in case we have an influx and need to close it off."

Sablan did not think a cap was necessary.

"If you look at market of overall basketball players, I don't think it's going to exceed 1,500, and if it does, the only hiccup we would have is using more facilities at the same time," Sablan said.

If there are too many teams and spectators to fit into one gym, Sablan said, they would need to operate the tournament in two or three villages at the same time instead of one per weekend.

However, if they can address the facilities constraint, Sablan said, the more the better.

received an overwhelming increase in overall participation," he said in a statement.

Shimizu said this level of international engagement "confirms that the Guam Marianas Open has formally entered the Asia-Pacific market as a premier and prestigious tournament platform."

"We extend our sincere appreciation to the Guam Visitors Bureau for its partnership and continued support, which has been instrumental in advancing sports tourism as a strategic pillar of Guam's economic recovery," he said. "COPA remains fully committed to working alongside the Guam Visitors Bureau and government stakeholders to systematically expand sports tourism and to position Guam as a leading international destination for elite sporting events."

As the PDN reported in November, the GVB board of directors voted to ap-

prove a \$550,000 sponsorship for the Marianas Open jiu jitsu tournament. The GVB board also previously gave \$500,000.

In a statement on Thursday, GVB General Manager Régine Biscoe Lee said GVB is looking forward to the Guam COPA de Marianas, supporting local competitors, and welcom-

ing international and U.S. athletes to Guam.

"This milestone in participation is more than just a success for our strong local BJJ community; it's a win for Guam as a recognized destination for premier athletic events, a key component of our island's return toward a thriving visitor economy," Biscoe Lee

added.

The Guam COPA de Marianas, in connection with the Guam Marianas Open and the Guam Marianas Pro Series, is the premier martial arts championship in Guam and the Mariana Islands, dedicated to promoting the sport of Brazilian jiu-jitsu through world-class competition.

She earned gold in the 50m freestyle, 100m freestyle, 200m freestyle, 400m freestyle, and 100m butterfly, along with silver medals in the 200m individual medley and the 100m backstroke events.



Her 50m freestyle performance of 27.45 set an AAU Junior Olympics record.

Micro Beach, American Memorial Park, Garapan. The starting ceremony will be held at 4:30 a.m., with the race "departing the station" at 5 a.m. The finish line closes at 9 p.m.

"Reviving this historic railway route alongside our partners from Japan holds meaning for both our community and our tourism industry," MVA Managing Director Jamika R. Tajjeron said in a statement. "This journey run brings the Marianas' Far From Ordinary brand to life by connecting athletes and visitors to the stories, landscapes, and shared history that makes our islands unique. As we continue improving our tourism products, we will explore the potential for growing this event, as it strengthens our ties with Japan while creating new experiences for visitors."

During the Japanese era, the Marianas was a major hub for sugarcane cultivation, with a legendary 50-mile narrow-gauge railway encircling Saipan, transporting sugarcane and goods—a legacy with remnants still found through the island's landscape.

Similar railways once ran

on the neighboring island of Tinian and Rota.

The story of The Marianas is a rich tapestry, woven from the heritage of the indigenous Chamorro and Carolinian people, and seasoned by centuries of Spanish, German, Japanese, and American influence.

During the endurance run, participants will also have the opportunity to fortify themselves with authentic local food at aid stations manned by local agencies and businesses, from Mt. Tapochau's base to Capital Hill, Banzai Cliff, Micro Beach and other spots.

"We anticipate that runners will be on the course from pre-dawn until after dark," MVA community projects manager Martin Duenas said. "We ask everyone's cooperation in making this inaugural race a safe success by restraining pet dogs along the route on Saturday and staying alert for runners along the road throughout the day. We appreciate everyone's support."

Safety, self-sufficiency, and respect for the Marianas' natural and historical heritage are top priorities for the race.

Participants must navigate using official course maps, pass all checkpoints, and carry mandatory night gear and cell phones.
