Matthew Joseph Aguon Santos, a student at JP Torres Success Academy, achieved the highest overall results among 27 individuals tested in fiscal year 2027 to enlist in the Guam Army National Guard, the Guam Department of Education and Guam Army National Guard said.

“Out of the 27 testers I have worked with in FY2027, PVT Matthew Aguon Santos achieved the highest overall score with an AFQT of 76 and a GT score of 110,” according to his proctor, SSG Juan Camacho, recruiting and retention noncommis-

sioned officer for the Guam Army National Guard.

In a media release, GDOE said it proudly recognizes Santos for successfully completing all requirements to enlist in the Guam Army National Guard and for earning a platinum badge on the WorkKeys Assessment, the highest level attainable.

Santos, of Tamuning, and others took the Armed Services Vocational Aptitude Battery, ASVAB, a standardized test to help predict success in military training and careers.
