**STIPULATED
SETTLEMENT AGREEMENT
AND ORDER**

COMES NOW, the Guam Police Department ("Management") and Peter Jesse Perez Leon Guerrero ("Employee") submits this Stipulated Settlement Agreement and Order for the approval of the Civil Service Commission of Guam "Commission". This agreement will resolve all issues before the Commission in the above-captioned case.

The parties have agreed to the following terms to resolve the above-captioned matter.

- 1. Employee shall be reinstated as a Police Officer II, lowest step;

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- 2. Employee shall be awarded back pay at the Police Officer II, lowest step, since the date of termination up until the date of reinstatement, which will be converted to demotion;
- 3. Employee shall submit to pre-employment drug testing, and Management shall waive the Background Investigation, Polygraph Test, and Psychological Evaluation;
- 4. Employee's date of reinstatement shall be provided upon the passing of his pre-employment drug test; and
- 5. Employee shall bear his own attorney's fees and costs.
