Please be advised that the Bills were transmitted to your office on January 29, 2026, at 7:04 p.m. On February 11, 2026, you returned the following bills without your signature:

Bill No 79-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIIZE *I MAGA'HÅGAN GUAHÅN* TO SELL A PORTION OF BLOCK 8 IN NEW AGAT DESIGNATED AS BLOCK 8 PARK AREA AND TO DEPOSIT THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE INTO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INFRASTRUCTURE AND SUVEY FUND."

Bill 251-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO AMEND § 31101 OF CHAPTER 31, DIVISION 4, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEE COMPOSITION TO ENHANCE BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY REPRESENTATION."

Bill No. 215-38 (COR), “AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO § 21103 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO WAIVING SANITARY PERMIT FEES FOR STUDENT SUPPORT FUNDRAISERS.”

Bill No. 240-38 (LS), “AN ACT TO AMEND § 61309, ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 61, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDING TEMPORARY WORKFORCE HOUSING AS A PERMITTED USE FOR M1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL ZONES.”

The Organic Act also requires the Governor to sign all bills the Governor intends to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No. 138-38 (COR), Bill No. 150-38 (LS), Bill No. 162-38 (COR), Bill No. 169-38 (COR), Bill No. 195-38 (COR), Bill No. 202-38 (COR), Bill No. 215-38 (COR), Bill No. 217-38 (COR), Bill No. 235-38 (COR) and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) were approved and dated February 11, 2026, after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill No. 138-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-94**, Bill No. 150-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-95**, Bill No. 162-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-96**, Bill No. 169-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-97**, Bill No. 195-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-98**, Bill No. 202-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-99**, Bill No. 215-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-100**, Bill No. 217-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-101**, Bill No. 235-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-102** and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-103**, respectively as of February 11, 2026.

In addition, the Organic Act of Guam requires the Governor to return all bills to the legislature in which the Governor does not intend to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No 79-38 (COR) and Bill 251-38 (COR) were returned unsigned on February 11, 2026, and after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill 79-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-104** and Bill 251-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-105**, respectively, on February 11, 2026.

Håfa Adai Mr. Speaker,

When a property owner seeks to rezone their property, it would be preferable that they go through the process established by law to allow for the maximum community input. In this situation, it appears the property in question is in an area where the surrounding property is also zoned as Light Industrial. Based on the committee report, it appears the surrounding property owners support the rezoning of this lot to Light Industrial.

The use of the legislative process to accomplish the rezoning of property should be used sparingly. If the Legislature believes the statutory process of rezoning a piece of property is too burdensome, then amending the process should be the result, as opposed to the piecemeal legislative rezoning of individual pieces of property.

For these reasons, I sign Bill No. 150-38 (LS) into law as **Public Law No. 38-95**.





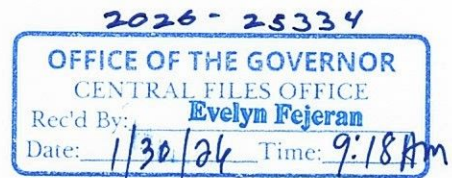

**AN ACT TO REZONE LOT NO. 5228-R4-R2-1 (PORTION)
IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF *BARRIGADA* FROM
AGRICULTURAL (“A”) TO LIGHT INDUSTRIAL (“M-
1”).**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* has
3 been approached by the owners of Lot. No. 5228-R4-R2-1 (Portion) requesting for
4 rezoning of their property to utilize said property to its highest and best use.

5 *I Liheslatura* finds that properties surrounding and contiguous to Lot No.
6 5228-R4-R2-1 (Portion) have already been rezoned to Light Industrial (“M-1”). *I*

1 *Liheslatura* further finds that the area is served by necessary infrastructure for light
2 industrial use.

3 **Section 2. Rezoning.** Lot. No. 5228-R4-R2-1 (Portion) situated in the
4 Municipality of *Barrigada* containing an area of 3,173 +/- square meters is hereby
5 rezoned from Agriculture (“A”) to Light Industrial (“M-1”) (Lot Parceling Map
6 Attached Hereto as Exhibit “A”).

7 **Section 3. Effective Date.** This Act *shall* be effective upon enactment.
