Please be advised that the Bills were transmitted to your office on January 29, 2026, at 7:04 p.m.

On February 11, 2026, you returned the following bills without your signature:

Bill No 79-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIIZE *I MAGA'HÅGAN GUAHAN* TO SELL A PORTION OF BLOCK 8 IN NEW AGAT DESIGNATED AS BLOCK 8 PARK AREA AND TO DEPOSIT THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE INTO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INFRASTRUCTURE AND SUVEY FUND."

Bill 251-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO AMEND § 31101 OF CHAPTER 31, DIVISION 4, TITLE 17, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO THE GUAM COMMUNITY COLLEGE BOARD OF TRUSTEE COMPOSITION TO ENHANCE BUSINESS AND INDUSTRY REPRESENTATION."

Bill No. 195-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 849.18 TO CHAPTER 8, TITLE 1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO RENAMING THE GEORGE WASHINGTON FOOTBALL FIELD AS THE LORING SANTOS CRUZ FIELD."

Bill No. 215-38 (COR), “AN ACT TO ADD A NEW SUBSECTION (e) TO § 21103 OF CHAPTER 21, DIVISION 2, TITLE 10, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO WAIVING SANITARY PERMIT FEES FOR STUDENT SUPPORT FUNDRAISERS.”

Bill No. 217-38 (COR), “AN ACT TO ADD A NEW § 70124 TO CHAPTER 70, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO AUTHORIZING LICENSED ELECTRICIANS TO CONDUCT WEATHERHEAD INSPECTIONS AND CERTIFICATION.”

Bill No. 235-38 (COR), “AN ACT TO AMEND § 58D108 OF CHAPTER 58, TITLE 5, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND TO AMEND SECTION 8 OF CHAPTER I OF PUBLIC LAW 38-60, RELATIVE TO FINANCING AND PREDEVELOPMENT STAGE EXPENSES FOR THE SIMON A. SANCHEZ HIGH SCHOOL PROJECT.”

Bill No. 240-38 (LS), “AN ACT TO AMEND § 61309, ARTICLE 3, CHAPTER 61, TITLE 21, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO ADDING TEMPORARY WORKFORCE HOUSING AS A PERMITTED USE FOR M1 LIGHT INDUSTRIAL ZONES.”

The Organic Act also requires the Governor to sign all bills the Governor intends to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No. 138-38 (COR), Bill No. 150-38 (LS), Bill No. 162-38 (COR), Bill No. 169-38 (COR), Bill No. 195-38 (COR), Bill No. 202-38 (COR), Bill No. 215-38 (COR), Bill No. 217-38 (COR), Bill No. 235-38 (COR) and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) were approved and dated February 11, 2026, after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill No. 138-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-94**, Bill No. 150-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-95**, Bill No. 162-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-96**, Bill No. 169-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-97**, Bill No. 195-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-98**, Bill No. 202-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-99**, Bill No. 215-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-100**, Bill No. 217-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-101**, Bill No. 235-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-102** and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-103**, respectively as of February 11, 2026.

In addition, the Organic Act of Guam requires the Governor to return all bills to the legislature in which the Governor does not intend to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No 79-38 (COR) and Bill 251-38 (COR) were returned unsigned on February 11, 2026, and after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill 79-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-104** and Bill 251-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-105**, respectively, on February 11, 2026.





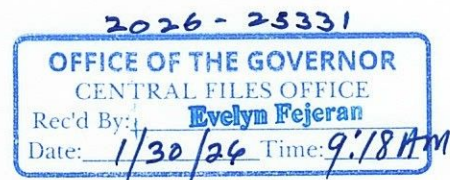

**AN ACT TO *ADD* A NEW § 849.18 TO CHAPTER 8, TITLE
1, GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, RELATIVE TO
RENAMING THE GEORGE WASHINGTON FOOTBALL
FIELD AS THE LORING SANTOS CRUZ FIELD.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* finds
3 that the late Loring Santos Cruz dedicated over thirty-six (36) years of his life as a
4 Physical Education teacher at George Washington High School, where he impacted
5 the lives of thousands of students, faculty, and staff through his unwavering
6 commitment to education and mentorship. In addition to his role as an educator,

1 Loring Santos Cruz was a legendary coach whose contributions extended beyond
2 the classroom to the football fields and track and field facilities of Guam, where he
3 became one of the island’s most celebrated and respected sports figures.

4 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that Coach Cruz began his coaching
5 career in 1976, serving as both an Assistant and Head Coach for the George
6 Washington High School football and track and field teams. He also served as the
7 Defensive Coach for the University of Guam Tritons and Head Coach for the Pepsi
8 Giants, leading his teams to numerous championships in the Interscholastic Football
9 League (IFL) and Miller Football League (MFL). His leadership and mentorship
10 inspired generations of students, many of whom have gone on to become leaders in
11 Guam’s sports community and beyond.

12 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* also finds that Coach Cruz’s legacy is evidenced by
13 his inclusion in multiple editions of “Who’s Who Among America’s Teachers,”
14 recognizing his excellence and influence as an educator and mentor. The George
15 Washington High School Football Field served as a central venue for Coach Cruz’s
16 storied career, where he not only coached championship teams but also instilled
17 values of discipline, teamwork, and perseverance in his players.

18 *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* further finds that renaming the George Washington
19 High School Football Field in honor of Loring Santos Cruz would serve as a lasting
20 tribute to his extraordinary contributions to education, sports, and the community,
21 ensuring that his legacy continues to inspire future generations.

22 **Section 2.** A new § 849.18 is *added* to Chapter 8, Title 1, Guam Code
23 Annotated, to read as follows:

24 **“§ 849.18. Designation of George Washington High School**
25 **Football Field as the “Loring Santos Cruz Field”.**

26 Notwithstanding any other provision of law, the George Washington
27 High School Football Field shall be renamed the Loring Santos Cruz Field in

1 recognition of the late Loring Santos Cruz, a distinguished athlete, coach, and
2 educator who devoted his life to promoting health, sports, and education for the
3 people of Guam.”

4 **Section 3. Severability.** If any provision of this Act or its application to any
5 person or circumstance is found to be invalid or inorganic, such invalidity shall not
6 affect other provisions or applications of this Act that can be given effect without
7 the invalid provision or application, and to this end the provisions of this Act are
8 severable.

9 **Section 4. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective upon enactment.
