On February 11, 2026, you returned the following bills without your signature:

Bill No 79-38 (COR), "AN ACT TO AUTHORIIZE *I MAGA'HÅGAN GUAHÅN* TO SELL A PORTION OF BLOCK 8 IN NEW AGAT DESIGNATED AS BLOCK 8 PARK AREA AND TO DEPOSIT THE PROCEEDS OF THE SALE INTO THE CHAMORRO LAND TRUST INFRASTRUCTURE AND SUVEY FUND."

The Organic Act also requires the Governor to sign all bills the Governor intends to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No. 138-38 (COR), Bill No. 150-38 (LS), Bill No. 162-38 (COR), Bill No. 169-38 (COR), Bill No. 195-38 (COR), Bill No. 202-38 (COR), Bill No. 215-38 (COR), Bill No. 217-38 (COR), Bill No. 235-38 (COR) and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) were approved and dated February 11, 2026, after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill No. 138-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-94**, Bill No. 150-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-95**, Bill No. 162-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-96**, Bill No. 169-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-97**, Bill No. 195-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-98**, Bill No. 202-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-99**, Bill No. 215-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-100**, Bill No. 217-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-101**, Bill No. 235-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-102** and Bill No. 240-38 (LS) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-103**, respectively as of February 11, 2026.

In addition, the Organic Act of Guam requires the Governor to return all bills to the legislature in which the Governor does not intend to approve within ten days of its presentation. Bill No 79-38 (COR) and Bill 251-38 (COR) were returned unsigned on February 11, 2026, and after the tenth day of presentation to you.

Therefore, Bill 79-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-104** and Bill 251-38 (COR) is lapsed into law as **Public Law 38-105**, respectively, on February 11, 2026.

*Håfa Adai* Mr. Speaker,

Bill No. 235-38 (COR) amends Section 58D108 of Chapter 58, Title 5 of the Guam Code Annotated and Section 8 of Chapter I of Public Law 38-60. It clarifies authorized financing options for the Simon A. Sanchez High School project, identifying additional federally supported financing tools that may be considered for alternative financing options provided in Section 58D108. While it provides clarification to the alternative financing provisions, it does not mandate that the government authorize or adopt any alternative financing.

Procurement for construction of the Simon Sanchez High School is ongoing. Just last week, the Department of Public Works ("DPW") issued a determination that awarding the contract for the project without delay was necessary to protect the government's substantial interests. Further delay would objectively harm students, families, and the community. Implementing new financing options at this stage would stall the project and likely require resolicitation of the project. This outcome would undo all of our progress toward completion of this critical facility.

Although this bill clarifies additional project funding tools, it does not require disruption to the current procurement process. It preserves DPW's discretion and allows the agency to continue under the existing RFP, keeping the ongoing procurement and impending award intact.

In the FY26 Budget Act, Public Law 38-60, the Legislature appropriated more than \$16 million for construction leaseback payments for the project. To support early project costs, Bill 235 expands the eligible use of these funds to include pre-development expenses, consistent with 5 GCA § 58D109. This change will help cover necessary start-up costs and improve cashflow allowing the project to move forward without further unnecessary delay.





**AN ACT TO *AMEND* § 58D108 OF CHAPTER 58, TITLE 5,  
GUAM CODE ANNOTATED, AND TO *AMEND* SECTION

FINANCING AND PREDEVELOPMENT STAGE  
EXPENSES FOR THE SIMON A. SANCHEZ HIGH  
SCHOOL PROJECT.**

1        **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2        **Section 1. Legislative Findings and Intent.** It is the intent of *I*  
3        *Liheslaturan Guåhan* to further articulate financing options for the Simon A.  
4        Sanchez High School project, to further appropriate a portion of the Net Projected  
5        Unobligated Fiscal Year 2025 General Fund Revenue Balance to fund lease back

1 payments and associated Pre-Development Stage expenses for the Simon A. Sanchez  
2 High School project, and to confirm that such financing options and expenditures  
3 are further authorized as set forth in this Act.

4 **Section 2.** § 58D108 of Chapter 58, Title 5, Guam Code Annotated, is  
5 hereby *amended* to read as follows:

6 **“§ 58D108. Financing.**

7 To minimize the cost to the government of Guam, financing utilized by  
8 the Contractor to fund the pre-development, construction of and FF&E  
9 services for the new Simon Sanchez High School shall be through tax-exempt  
10 obligations, or other financial instruments; provided, that such financing is  
11 available at an interest rate of no more than eight-and-a-half percent (8.5%).  
12 The contractor may use an alternative method of financing, including, but not  
13 limited to, a short-term debt, mortgage, loan, federally guaranteed loan, or  
14 loan by an instrumentality of the United States of America, including, but not  
15 limited to, Community Development Financial Institution (CDFI) programs  
16 such as the Capital Magnet Fund, the EB-5 Immigrant Investor Program, New  
17 Markets Tax Credit financing, Community Reinvestment Act-motivated  
18 lending, or any other federally authorized financing mechanism, if such  
19 financing will better serve the needs of the people of Guam, subject to  
20 approval by *I Liheslaturan Guåhan*. The principal amount of financing  
21 authorized under this Section shall not exceed One Hundred Sixty-six Million  
22 Three Hundred Sixty-five Thousand Dollars (\$166,365,000).”

23 **Section 3.** Section 8 of Chapter I of Public Law 38-60 is hereby *amended*  
24 to read as follows:

25 **“Section 8.** Notwithstanding any other provision of law, Sixteen  
26 Million Three Hundred Seventy-seven Thousand One Hundred Twenty-five  
27 Dollars (**\$16,377,125**) is hereby appropriated from the Net Projected

1 Unobligated Fiscal Year 2025 General Fund Revenue Balance as identified in  
2 the June 2025 Consolidated Revenue and Expenditure Report for the Simon  
3 A. Sanchez High School construction lease back payments and associated pre-  
4 development stage expenses.”
