#18 Little Jon Aguon sits in fifth in the championship standing with 152 points.

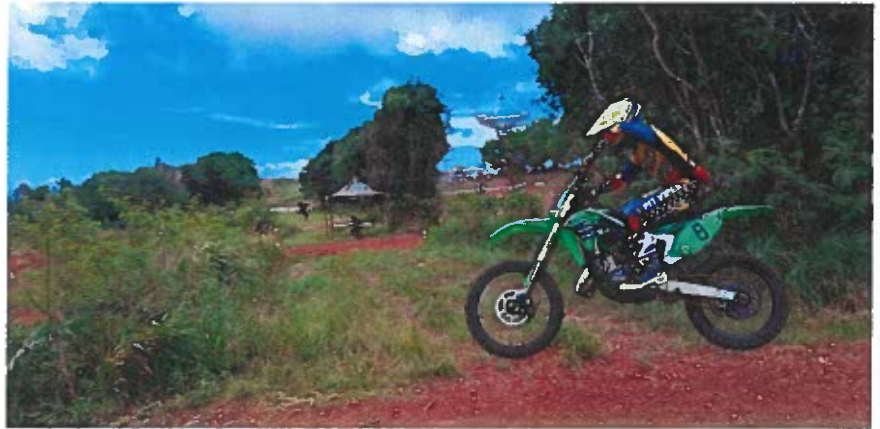
Open ATV
