Håfa Adai Speaker Blas:

In light of the approaching Tropical Storm Sinlaku and the urgent need to ensure that adequate resources are available to support response and recovery efforts, I am calling *I Liheslaturan Guåhan* into special session to consider legislation appropriating emergency funds.

Based on current forecasts from the National Weather Service, Tropical Storm Sinlaku is expected to intensify as it approaches Guam, with the potential for damaging winds, heavy rainfall, and hazardous sea conditions beginning as early as April 12, 2026. In anticipation of these impacts, I placed the island in Condition of Readiness 3 at 5:30 p.m. today, April 10, 2026, with further escalation expected. Government agencies have begun mobilizing resources and implementing protective measures.

While existing emergency authorities allow for initial response actions, including limited emergency procurement, those authorities are not sufficient to sustain the level of response and recovery that may be required. The scale of the anticipated impacts presents a credible and significant threat to public safety, infrastructure, and essential services across the island.

Transmitted herewith is proposed legislation to appropriate approximately \$25 million from the General Fund to support emergency response efforts, including food, water, sheltering, medical services, infrastructure stabilization, and Individual Assistance for impacted residents, as well as direct support to mayors to address immediate community-level needs.

EXPENSES IN RESPONSE TO TROPICAL STORM *SINLAKU*.**

1 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:**

2 **Section 1. Emergency Expenses.** Notwithstanding any other provision or
3 law, and in addition to existing authorities under 5 GCA §22402 and in Public Law
4 38-60, the sum of Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000.00) is appropriated
5 from the General Fund to *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* [the Governor of Guam] for
6 emergency response and recovery expenses in response to Tropical Storm *Sinlaku*.
7 Such expenses include, but are not limited to, costs related to safety and security;
8 food, water, and sheltering; health and medical services; energy; communications;
9 transportation; and hazardous materials. Individual Assistance is authorized under
10 this Section, supported by survey and damage assessment data. *I Maga'håga* shall
11 disburse One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the funds appropriated
12 herein to each mayor, who may utilize such monies for the purposes identified above.
13 Mayors shall report all expenditure of funds provided herein to *I Maga'håga* within
14 forty-five (45) days of expenditure. *I Maga'håga* shall provide a written report of all

1 expenditure of funds under this Act, including those expended by the mayors, to *I*
2 *Liheslaturan Guåhan* and the Public Auditor within sixty (60) days of initial
3 disbursement and periodically thereafter. All expenditures shall be managed to
4 ensure continuity of essential Executive Branch operations.

5 **Section 2. Effective Date.** This Act shall be effective immediately.
