EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 2026-02

**RELATIVE TO PROVIDING TEMPORARY INCOME TAX,
BUSINESS PRIVILEGE TAX, PROPERTY TAX, AND OTHER TAX
FILING AND PAYMENT RELIEF IN ANTICIPATION
OF THE IMPACTS OF TYPHOON SINLAKU**

WHEREAS, on April 10, 2026, the National Weather Service, Guam Weather Forecast Office (“NWS”), forecast that Super Typhoon Sinlaku, a high Category 4 typhoon, is steadily intensifying and maintaining a track toward the Mariana Islands, with its closest point of approach to Guam presently anticipated at 3:00 PM on Tuesday, April 14, 2026; and

WHEREAS, while Sinlaku’s track has shifted northward, Guam is currently under a tropical storm warning and a typhoon watch. The likelihood of typhoon conditions on Guam depends on any southward shift in Sinlaku’s track; and

WHEREAS, the potential exists for destructive winds, heavy rainfall, and dangerous seas and surf beginning on or about April 13–14, 2026, with tropical-storm-force and potentially typhoon-force winds capable of causing island-wide power outages, damage to infrastructure, and disruption of transportation and communications throughout Guam; and

WHEREAS, based on this information, I elevated our island to Condition of Readiness (COR) 2 on Sunday, April 12, 2026, at 5:00 PM. Under COR2, Government offices will be closed with the exception of essential services, and many private businesses, including financial institutions and tax preparers, will likely close until Sinlaku passes our island and we are restored to COR4; and

WHEREAS, while the filing deadline for income tax returns is scheduled for April 15, 2026, conditions are reasonably expected to interfere with the ability of individuals and businesses to gather records and timely file income tax returns and remit payments by the April 15, 2026 deadline; and

WHEREAS, the federal tax code authorizes the postponement of certain tax deadlines for affected taxpayers, including the filing of returns and payment of taxes, upon a Presidential emergency declaration. Because Guam’s tax code mirrors the federal code, this measure is similarly available to our island upon a Presidential emergency declaration; and

WHEREAS, on April 13, 2026, President Donald J. Trump approved my request for a pre-landfall Presidential emergency declaration for Guam related to Typhoon Sinlaku, confirming the serious threat that this storm poses to our island and the need for federal assistance and resources; and

WHEREAS, in light of the Presidential declaration and the anticipated disruptions associated with Typhoon Sinlaku, Lt. Governor Joshua F. Tenorio and I find that it is in the best interest of our island to provide temporary relief from income tax filing and payment deadlines that would otherwise fall on April 15, 2026, and from penalties and interest on other territorial tax obligations due in April 2026, to avoid penalizing taxpayers for delays caused by storm-related conditions and to allow them to focus on protecting life, health, and property; and

WHEREAS, accordingly, I intend to direct the Department of Revenue and Taxation (“DRT”) to implement all necessary measures and issue all relevant notices to carry out the intent of this Order.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, LOURDES A. LEON GUERRERO, I Maga’hågan Guåhan, Governor of Guam, by virtue of the authority vested in me by the Organic Act of Guam, as amended, and the laws of Guam, do hereby order as follows:

1. Extension of Territorial Income Tax Filing and Payment Deadlines.

- a. The April 15, 2026 deadline to file Guam territorial income tax returns, including but not limited to individual, corporate, and other business entity returns, is hereby extended for a period of thirty (30) days to May 15, 2026.
- b. The April 15, 2026 deadline to pay Guam territorial income tax, including any balance due with returns, is likewise extended for a period of thirty (30) days to May 15, 2026.

2. Temporary Suspension of Penalties and Interest on Territorial Income Tax During the Extension Period.

- a. DRT shall not impose failure-to-file or failure-to-pay penalties on any Guam territorial income tax return filed or payment made on or before May 15, 2026.

- b. For purposes of interest accrual on any unpaid Guam territorial income tax liability otherwise due on April 15, 2026, the due date is extended to May 15, 2026.
- c. Returns filed or payments made after May 15, 2026 shall be subject to penalties and interest in accordance with applicable law, calculated as if the original due date were May 15, 2026.
- d. For any Guam territorial income tax return required to be filed on or before the extended due date that is not filed on such date, penalties may apply as provided by law unless the failure is shown to be due to reasonable cause and not due to willful neglect. The Director of Revenue and Taxation may determine whether reasonable cause exists to permit relief from such penalties. This subsection is consistent with 26 U.S.C. § 6651.

3. Temporary Suspension of Penalties and Interest on Business Privilege Tax and Associated Tax Liabilities.

- a. DRT shall not impose any late-payment or late-filing penalties, and no interest shall accrue or be assessed, for the Business Privilege Tax and any associated territorial tax liabilities, provided that the required returns, filings, and payments are made in full on or before May 31, 2026.
- b. For purposes of interest accrual on such tax liabilities, the due date is extended to May 31, 2026.

4. Administrative Implementation.

The Director of Revenue and Taxation is directed to take all actions necessary to implement this Executive Order, including issuing public guidance, updating electronic filing and payment systems, and coordinating with tax preparers and financial institutions.

5. No Effect on Other Obligations.

Except as expressly provided in this Executive Order, all other obligations of taxpayers under Guam law, including information reporting and withholding obligations, shall remain in full force and effect.
