The Judiciary of Guam respectfully submits this memorandum along with the Unclassified Appointment Report prepared in accordance with 4 GCA § 2201, *et seq.* (Public Law 38-37). As required, the Judiciary must compile, maintain, and transmit a report of all unclassified appointments to the Speaker of I Liheslaturan Guåhan.

Unclassified appointments are governed by standards established by the Judicial Council. In 2005, through Resolution No. JC05-007, the Council adopted four standards that define when positions may be placed in the unclassified service, such as positions of a confidential nature, those involving policy-making or formulation, temporary or seasonal positions, and professional or technical roles requiring skills not readily available in Guam's labor market and recognized under U.S. Department of Labor occupational listings.

Since their adoption in 2005, the Judiciary has consistently and continuously applied these standards for more than twenty-one years, ensuring a uniform, transparent, and accountable personnel structure across the Judicial Branch. This longstanding adherence demonstrates the Judiciary's commitment to principled and legally grounded personnel practices.







Traveler's Report (Highlight the information you gathered at the event and how it impacts your role/responsibilities at the Judiciary. Describe how it will be beneficial to achieving the Judiciary's mission of delivering justice fairly and efficiently through transparent, inclusive, and accessible court services.)

I attended the Conference of Chief Justices Midyear Meeting in San Juan, Puerto Rico, as the official representative of the Judiciary of Guam. Hosted by Chief Justice Maite D. Oronoz Rodríguez of the Supreme Court of Puerto Rico and presided over by Chief Justice Collins J. Seitz, Jr. of the Supreme Court of Delaware, the meeting convened chief justices from across the United States and its jurisdictions to address judicial leadership, accountability, and institutional integrity. The program opened with a Law and Literature session centered on Puerto Rico: A National History by Jorell Meléndez-Badillo, which examined how history, identity, and sovereignty shape legal institutions and civic expectations, underscoring the importance of collective memory and public trust in maintaining judicial legitimacy.

Educational sessions focused on the evolving responsibilities of chief justices in promoting transparency, effective governance, and public confidence in the courts. Discussions addressed budget reductions in several jurisdictions and highlighted strategies such as data-driven decision-making, fiscal accountability, and strengthened communication with the legislative and executive branches. A plenary update was delivered by Michelle A. Behnke, President of the American Bar Association, followed by a session on artificial intelligence in the courts that examined both the efficiencies and ethical considerations associated with generative AI tools. Additional programming addressed court security initiatives, including lessons learned from recent statewide audits, and provided an update from the National Council of Bar Examiners on the development and scoring framework of the NextGen Bar Exam.

The information gathered at this meeting directly informs my responsibilities as a Justice and as Guam's representative within the national judicial community. The discussions on accountability and budget stewardship provide practical models for strengthening transparent governance and data-informed policy decisions within our Judiciary. The AI session underscored the importance of adopting emerging technologies thoughtfully, with appropriate safeguards to protect due process, privacy, and public confidence. Security briefings reinforced the need for continued vigilance in protecting judges, court personnel, and court users. Collectively, these insights support our mission to deliver justice fairly and efficiently by enhancing transparency, improving operational effectiveness, strengthening public trust, and ensuring that our court services remain inclusive, accessible, and responsive to the community we serve.

I sent Chief Justice Maraman the conference materials. Attached are my receipts and other documents.
