

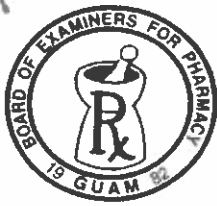

to a 25-17 win.

Set two brought more resistance from the Royals, who matched Father Duenas point-for-point through much of the frame.

However, after the mid-way mark, the Friars found their way to a late surge, creating separation for Notre Dame to manage just one additional point compared to the previous set. FD closed out set two at 25-18.

we're very confident coming from our championship last year. [We were able to keep] most of the same guys [and lost] very few... but we just have to keep working hard in practice, we can't slack off," Egurrola said.

Now four games into the season, FD appears to be finding its stride after a slower-than-expected start. With several schedule disruptions still affecting the league, both teams are eager to regain momentum as the season continues.

Notre Dame tightened its play, relying on cleaner, more controlled rallies to stay competitive.

Despite briefly trailing, the Royals rallied late and edged out the Friars in a tightly contested finish, 26-24, handing FD their only set loss of the night.

While Egurrola led the charge, the Friars' depth proved equally important. Saul Bamba and Kobe Miyashita provided key support on both blocks and kills, contributing to a well-rounded team performance.


Still, the Friars could

not diminish the standout strikes that came from the other side of the net for Notre Dame as Piper Takoda stood out offensively, delivering the big kills that would keep his team in contention.

Egurrola continues to lead the Friars in offense with his presence at the net. "All hard work," he said about the team's preparation.

Looking ahead, he expressed confidence in the team's trajectory.

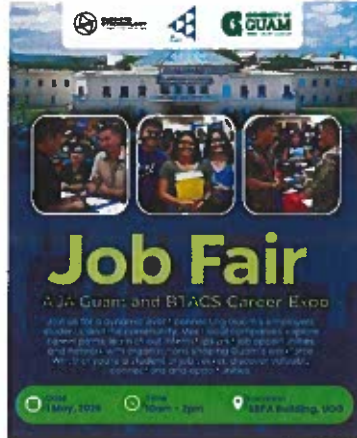
# BTACS, JA Guam to host islandwide job fair on May 1

the earliest in the Pacific to fish for deep ocean species such as tuna, marlin, and mahimahi.

Their knowledge extended across reef, shoreline, and open sea, with a wide range of practices that included everything from constructing various types of stone gigao (fish weirs) to offshore techniques like the poi'u.

But beyond its technical brilliance, the poi'u tells a deeper story. It speaks to a way of life where knowledge and skill was passed down through generations, effort was collective, and success was measured not only in what was caught, but in how it was shared.

Today, while some of these practices, such as fishing with the poi'u, have faded or changed, efforts to learn them again provide an opportunity to reconnect with and learn from the wisdom of the past.


