**ASSOCIATE OF SCIENCE IN PRACTICAL NURSING**

The Associate of Science in Practical Nursing 2024-2025 cohort, which graduated on May 8, 2025, currently has a 92% first-write pass rate, with 22 of 24 students passing the NCLEX-PN exam on their first attempt. There are three remaining students preparing to take their licensing exam, and they are anticipated to do so before the end of the year.

The 2025-2026 ASPN students are currently in their second semester cohort, which started on January 7, 2026. For the 2026 spring semester, the students are completing NU230 Maternal and Newborn Nursing Concepts and NU240 Pediatric Nursing Concepts. Each course encompasses 20 hours of lecture, 35 hours of lab, and 45 hours of clinical hours, which took place at Dr. Sheih's Clinic and the Guam Memorial Hospital's Labor and Delivery Ward, OB Ward, Nursery Ward, and Pediatric Ward. Additionally, the cohort completed 90 hours of lecture and 45 hours of labs for NU220 Medical-Surgical Nursing.

Between January and February 2026, the 2025-2026 ASPN cohort organized Jamaican Grill food coupon fundraisers. They donated \$500.00 from their proceeds to the Guam and CNMI Make-A-Wish Foundation.

The Nursing and Allied Health Department continues to seek qualified adjunct faculty to instruct the laboratory and clinical components of NU-level courses required for the program.

Students who are interested in the Associate of Science in Practical Nursing are highly encouraged to seek guidance from the Nursing & Allied Health Department. The next application period for the 2026-2027 ASPN cohort will be during the 2026 fall semester, with the next cohort anticipated to start in the 2027 spring semester.


