



	<p>Camacho, and although the legislative confirmation hearing had not yet been scheduled, the nomination packet had already been submitted to the legislature. B. Sablan also provided a reminder that the conflict of interest forms were due on April 22 to the Guam Election Commission, with instructions that members could either submit the forms through the office or deliver them in person. Dr. Balajadia subsequently asked which members had already submitted their reports and discussed making copies available, while it was also indicated that additional forms would be printed and brought to the conference room for distribution and submission assistance.</p>

Sablan expressed multiple attempts had been made by HPLO to obtain necessary medical records and consent forms from the complainant for both complaints sent to Dr. Turner, the territorial veterinarian, without success. She clarified that the inability to secure the complainant's consent prevented the release of medical records by the clinic, thereby hindering the investigator's ability to proceed, and that the complainant had become unresponsive despite initiating the complaint.</p> <p>A discussion arose regarding procedural considerations related to the complaint, during which it was noted that if no actionable findings could be established through proper procedures, the matter may need to be dismissed. It was suggested that no immediate decision should be made at the next meeting, but rather that all relevant information be gathered in advance to allow for a thorough review of the process followed. Concerns were also raised about the potential applicability of any statute of limitations and whether the matter could be revisited in accordance with proper procedures. VII	<p><b>Old Business</b></p> <p><b>A. Review of Pending Bills</b></p> <p><b>i. Bill No. 276-38: “Relative to including dry needling and spinal manipulation as authorized activities for licensed practitioners of Acupuncture and Oriental Medicine”.</b></p> <p>Dr. Chong provided context for the bill, noting that dry needling and spinal manipulation are already practiced under acupuncture and Oriental medicine through Tuina, a traditional Chinese manual therapy encompassing whole-body joint manipulation, and that other licensed professions such as physical therapists and osteopathic practitioners are similarly permitted to perform spinal manipulation. He expressed that the intent of the bill was to formally codify these practices within the acupuncturist's scope of practice to prevent professional disputes.</p> <p>Dr. Miller raised concerns regarding the adequacy of training hours for the procedures in question, requesting that documentation be provided to demonstrate that licensed acupuncturists meet the didactic and clinical hour requirements necessary to perform dry needling and spinal manipulation. Dr. Harper further noted that any expansion of scope would need to be grounded in a clearly established syllabus aligned with existing licensing standards under the Guam Health Practice Act.</p> <p>A discussion ensued regarding the overlap between professions and the interpretation of existing statutes, during which it was acknowledged that differences in professional opinion would be difficult to resolve at the board level without dedicated time for review. Dr. Balajadia proposed that the item be removed from the agenda and referred to a work group to allow the involved parties to review scope-of-practice definitions, reconcile training requirements, and present a unified position prior to any recommendation being submitted to the legislature.</p> <p><b>ii. ing autism programs and government assistance for children with special needs “far beyond what Guam could even imagine.”

The mother said the move benefited Connor and allowed him to receive the care and assistance he needed to understand his autism and how to interact with people.

### Connor's Crew

She said their softball team consists primarily of family members who moved to Arizona from Guam, plus some friends the family made after moving out there.

They decided to name the team “Connor's Crew” and used the autism symbol on team jerseys and posters.

The team plays in the Cactus Yards Men's D Division.

“Since softball is such a big sport here in Arizona, what better way to advocate for autism and bring autism more into the community than creating a softball team centered just around Connor?” Cepeda said.

She added that many people in the community or on other teams they played against are wanting to buy a Connor's Crew jersey, “just because of the autism symbol and what our team represents.”

Connor's Crew competes in four seasons per year, winning its second championship, most recently in February. It won its first championship in the summer of 2025.

The team is also off to a great start in its current season, winning its first two games, 11-5 and 14-13, at the end of March.

“Every time we make it into the championship games, he is ecstatic. I'm the champion. You guys made me a champion. He was so excited when we won that championship on

Feb. 13, he ran the bases. He just was so excited that Connor's Crew was the champions,” Cepeda said.

The youngest member of the team is Cepeda's nephew, who is 17 years old. She said the oldest is around 45 years old, “so it's a good range.”

Cepeda said the team welcomes people from all walks of life, from police officers to business owners.

“We really approached it with diversity. We don't discriminate whatever race you are. We don't care. That's what our culture is, coming from Guam. We accept everyone and turn friends into family. This team really has that familial center. We treat each other like family. There's not much more we can ask from our team,” Cepeda said.

### Taste of Guam

Ethnically, the team is made up of mostly CHamorus and Filipinos, but everyone who joins takes part in “what the island culture is about, what Guam is about, our attitudes, the way we welcome people, the way we feed people.”

“These guys have never tried CHamoru food,

but during our barbecues, that's what we have. It does bring them into our culture, and...these guys want to go to visit Guam,” Cepeda said.

Cepeda said her son is the inspiration behind the team and is functionally the team's mascot. She said he is the reason why everyone works hard to get into the championship, “so that Connor's Crew can be a staple out there.”

“Autism is such a large spectrum, so what we want to do is just bring it out in the open. We are all adults here, advocating for acceptance of autism, and winning championships just makes it even louder,” Cepeda said.

The biggest benefit of the team is her son seeing that he has all these people care so much about him and are there to support him through anything, Cepeda added.

She said the team has allowed him to learn how to interact with others, come out of his shell, and give him emotional and physical support.

“They're behind Connor 110% as if they are his family,” Cepeda said.

Cepeda added that there isn't always a support system for people with special needs, or for CHamorus who first move out to the mainland.

“When we first moved out here, we didn't know anyone, so all [Connor] had was me, my husband, my sister, my brother-in-law, and my parents whenever they'd come out. That was really the only support system that he had,” Cepeda said.

### Celebrate wins, losses

Cepeda said having her son at the forefront of the team has made its players and supporters all more understanding and accepting of people with autism.

“Everyone comes together [to] celebrate our wins, celebrate our losses,

and celebrate Connor. He's such a big role in our family, like our extended family and our friends have never been around someone with autism. Connor has been an eye opener to a lot of our team, [young and old],” Cepeda said.

The softball team is not the only outlet Cepeda uses to support and spread awareness for autism.

“I have a small business, and it's called CVC (Connor Vincent Cepeda) customs, and my logo is a silhouette of my son. I do a lot of laser work, cutting and engraving promotional items. We do custom clothing, hats, woodworking, the whole works,” she said.

Cepeda added that she was never able to find

work, because she had to be her son's support when he was doing ABA therapy 20 hours a week for two years.

She said he is still doing therapies, which doesn't allow her to get a full-time job, which is why Cepeda opened a small business.

“I just want people to know that even strangers can become family and become that village for your family and your child with special needs, and that's what this team is doing. We've become family with strangers that love my son as much as I do, as much as my husband does,” Cepeda said. “Unfortunately, yes, we do miss home, and home will always be there.”
