Dr. Balajadia reiterated information provided in the Administrator's report regarding the public hearing scheduled for May 6, 2026, concerning Bill 276-38, which relates to dry needling and spinal manipulation as authorized activities for licensed practitioners of acupuncture and oriental medicine. The Board was then asked if there were any additional questions regarding the matter. Dr. Miller raised concerns that this was the third Board meeting in which the matter had been discussed and that a previously approved motion required the Board to withhold any recommendation or action regarding the legislation until adequate proof of education and training in spinal manipulation had been provided by the acupuncture representative, Dr. Chong. 	educational standards, safety standards, or related qualifications had yet been submitted for Board review. As a result, Dr. Miller emphasized that the Board could not formally endorse the bill or take an official position until the required information had been analyzed in accordance with the prior motion. It was further noted that, in the absence of such documentation, concerns remained regarding whether adequate educational preparation existed to support the proposed scope of practice. During the discussion, D. Harper questioned whether proposed legislation was required to receive Board approval prior to submission to the Legislature and suggested that this procedural issue may have contributed to the ongoing confusion. In response, D. Miller clarified that the primary concern centered specifically on the bill authorizing spinal manipulative therapy and the qualifications necessary for an acupuncturist to perform such procedures. D. Miller further explained that the Board was requesting objective proof of adequate education and training standards comparable to established professional benchmarks and reiterated that the requested information had not yet been provided. Dr. Chong stated that supporting information regarding educational qualifications and training had already been provided to the Board and asserted that spinal manipulation was included within the scope of practice under the Allied Health Practice Act for acupuncture and oriental medicine practitioners. Dr. Chong further referenced educational hours completed in Western medicine science and acupuncture-oriented medicine training, maintaining that the practice fell within the profession's recognized modalities and was distinct from chiropractic practice. In response, Dr. Miller reiterated concerns that the Board had not received formal written documentation sufficient to satisfy the previously approved motion requiring proof of education and training standards related to spinal manipulative therapy. It was emphasized that verbal explanations alone were insufficient and that the Board required written analyses, curricula, syllabi, and documentation from accredited educational institutions demonstrating the number of hours and scope of training specifically related to spinal manipulative therapy. Additional discussion focused on the need to compare oriental medicine educational standards with chiropractic standards, particularly because spinal manipulative therapy is recognized under chiropractic law and involves specific educational and clinical requirements.

		Dr. Harper raised questions regarding whether the proposed scope expansion sought to duplicate or overlap with chiropractic practice and whether the terminology used in the legislation created confusion between traditional oriental medicine modalities and chiropractic spinal manipulation. Dr. Miller further asserted that any determination by the Board must be based on objective documentation from accredited institutions rather than personal statements regarding qualifications. The Board also discussed obtaining copies of transcripts and related paperwork for formal review. Dr. Chong maintained that acupuncture and oriental medicine practitioners are not chiropractors and therefore should not be held to chiropractic educational standards, emphasizing that spinal manipulation is only one component of broader oriental medicine training. It was further explained that the proposed language was intended to clarify that acupuncture and oriental medicine practitioners may perform spinal manipulation within their existing scope of practice. Dr. Miller concluded with renewed emphasis that the Board's prior motion required formal written proof and analysis of accredited educational standards before any endorsement or recommendation regarding the bill could be considered. It was reiterated that, until such documentation was submitted and reviewed, the Board could not take an official position on the legislation due to insufficient information regarding qualifications and training standards. Dr. Balajadia reminded that the public hearing would take place the following Wednesday at 1:00 p.m. before the Legislature, and members interested in discussing the matter were encouraged to attend and provide testimony. Dr. Miller indicated that his testimony would reflect the concerns previously discussed by the Board. Dr. Balajadia stated that her attendance at the hearing would be as Board Chair but noted that no official statement or position could be represented on behalf of the Board by her in that capacity.

Student Body Association
president, plans to study
business administration
while pursuing a minor in
logistics.

As they prepare to leave
Guam, the athletes also re-
cognized the significance of
becoming role models for
younger players hoping to
follow a similar path.

"Going to college already
feels like a blessing, but be-
ing able to go and play a
sport I love is just, honestly,
out of this world for me,"
Rifley said. "I really think
being able to come back
and ... help teams and help
inspire the younger genera-
tion will be something that
I ... definitely look forward
to."

Mafnas hopes their ac-
complishments encourage
younger athletes to take
chances and pursue oppor-
tunities outside their com-
fort zones.

"I hope this gives young-
er generations the courage
to put themselves out there
and to take the risk of try-
ing new things," Mafnas
said. "All of us have a fear
of being unsure (about) go-
ing out and playing at such
a high level ... but if we
didn't take a risk ... I don't
think we would be here to-
day."

Sablan said the responsi-
bility of being watched by
younger players serves as
motivation.

"Having that pressure
of the younger generation
watching me will really
help me to push myself

harder to become better
just for them," Sablan said.
"They say pressure builds
diamonds, so I feel like that
pressure is going to help me
to really focus on every-
thing I can do to become
better."

Aldis stressed that suc-
cess at the next level re-
quires dedication both on
the field and in the class-
room.

"If you're going to work
hard on the field, you have
also got to work hard ac-
ademically," Aldis said.
"[To] younger generations:
just care about your classes.
Keep your grades up. Make
sure you're doing well.
Don't slip up, and you can
do anything after that."

On a lighter note, the
athletes also reference what
food they will miss most af-
ter leaving the island given
Guam's relationship with
food culture that they will
be leaving behind. Rifley
drew cheers from the crowd
with her answer of Spam
(the Guam version - since
she has been hearing that
Spam is different stateside),
while Sablan chose chicken
kaguen, Mafnas selected
kådag, and Aldis, represent-
ing his Pohnpeian roots
with an FSM dish mention,
said he would miss 'fish and
kon'.

With their signatures
now official, the quartet
joins a growing list of Guam
rugby athletes advancing to
the collegiate ranks, carry-
ing both their talents and
island culture with them as
they begin the next chapter
of their journeys.
