“RELATIVE TO EXPRESSING THE INTENT OF THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY BOARD OF TRUSTEES TO SEEK FINANCING THROUGH THE GUAM ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AUTHORITY (GEDA) FOR THE GUAM MEMORIAL HOSPITAL AUTHORITY LABOR AND DELIVERY WARD RENOVATION PROJECT”

WHEREAS, the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority (“GMHA” or the “Authority”) is a public corporation and autonomous instrumentality of the Government of Guam established pursuant to 10 GCA, Division 4, Chapter 80, charged with the responsibility of operating the Guam Memorial Hospital and providing quality, safe, and accessible healthcare services to the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, the GMHA Board of Trustees (the “Board”) is vested with the general powers necessary to govern the affairs of the Authority and to ensure the continued delivery of essential healthcare services, including maternal and child healthcare; and

WHEREAS, the Labor and Delivery Ward of the Guam Memorial Hospital is a critical component of the Authority’s maternal and child healthcare services, and the renovation of this ward (the “Labor and Delivery Ward Renovation Project” or the “Project”) is necessary to modernize the facility, enhance patient safety, improve the quality of care provided to expectant mothers and newborns, and ensure compliance with current healthcare standards; and

WHEREAS, the architectural and engineering specifications for the Labor and Delivery Ward Renovation Project have been completed and duly reviewed, and that this resolution shall serve as the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees formal approval of these specifications, as required by Title 10 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 80, Section 80109, Subsection (v)(1)(B);

WHEREAS, the Board has determined that financing is required in order to fund the design, construction, equipping, and completion of the Labor and Delivery Ward Renovation Project, and that pursuing such financing through the Guam Economic Development Authority (“GEDA”) is in the best interest of the Authority and the people of Guam; and

WHEREAS, Title 10 Guam Code Annotated, Chapter 80, Section 80109, Subsection (v), as amended, expressly authorizes financing, including a line of credit, a direct loan, or alternative financing, for the renovation of the Guam Memorial Hospital Labor and Delivery Ward, also known as the GMHA Maternal and Child Healthcare (MCH) Renovation Project, in a principal amount not to exceed Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,200,000.00); and

WHEREAS, the Board, in the exercise of its fiduciary duty and statutory authority, finds it appropriate, prudent, and necessary to formally express its intent to seek financing through GEDA in the full authorized amount of Nine Million Two Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$9,200,000.00) for the Labor and Delivery Ward Renovation Project;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, that the Guam Memorial Hospital Authority Board of Trustees hereby expresses its intent to seek financing through the Guam Economic

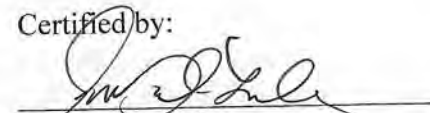
