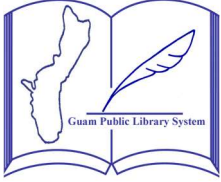

OUR MISSION

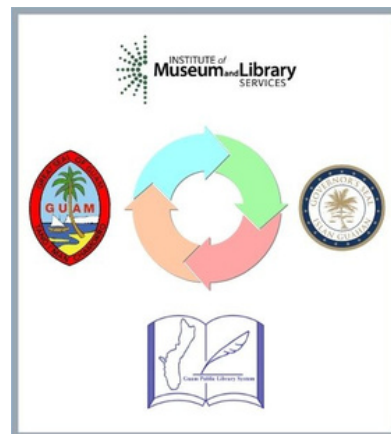

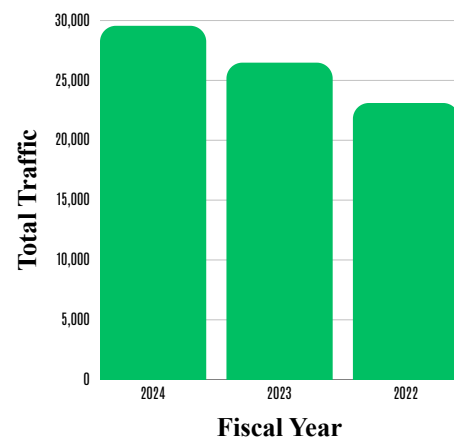
OUR PRIMARY SOURCE OF FEDERAL SUPPORT

Key Achievements in FY 2024

- New Learning Resource Center (LRC) at the Hagåtña Library providing a safe and welcoming space where children and young adults can access a range of resources and activities designed to support their learning and development. The LRC is free, offering study spaces, computers, board games, activity-based learning and free books.
- GPLS received the Notice of Award of the 2nd funding cycle for the 5-year plan (2023-2027) with the Institute of Museum and Library Services for \$163,982.
- Successfully reactivated a lapsed contract to reinstate eBooks for implementation in FY2025.
- In our continued commitment under the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with UOG Press/MARC (May 2021) and supporting cultural literacy, GPLS increased its inventory collection by 44% from the previous fiscal year.
- Successful hosting of the Governor's Summer Youth Employment Program (GSYEP) in June of 2024.

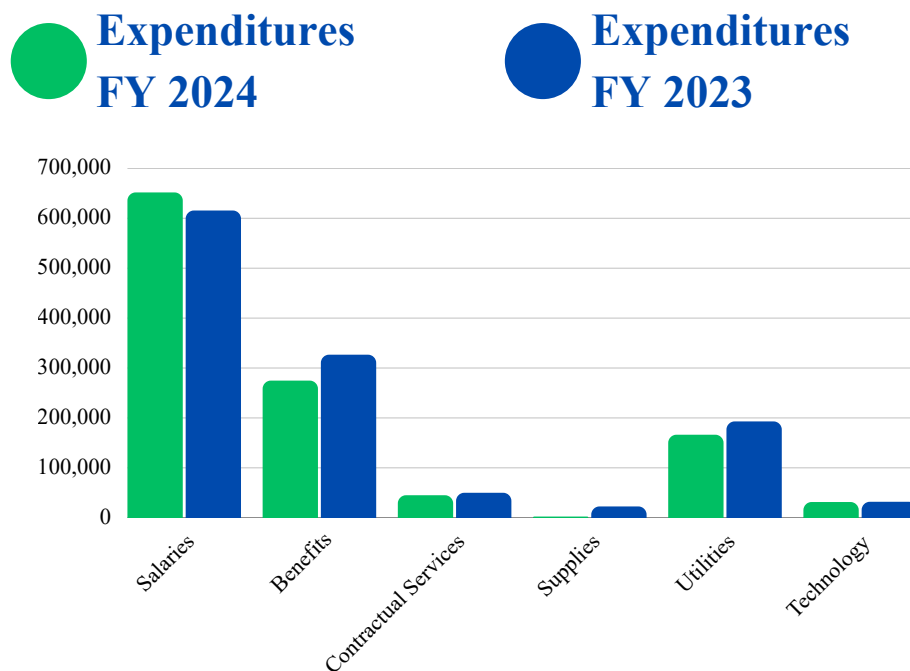
