**AN ACT TO REALLOCATE UNEXPENDED
EMERGENCY FUNDS FROM THE TYPHOON
SINLAKU APPROPRIATION TO *I MAGA'HÅGAN*
GUÅHAN FOR EMERGENCY RESPONSE TO
TROPICAL DEPRESSION 09W (BAVI).**

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF GUAM:

Section 1. Emergency Expenses. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, and in addition to existing authorities under 5 GCA §22402 and Public Law 38-60, any unexpended balance of the Twenty-Five Million Dollars (\$25,000,000) previously appropriated for emergency response and recovery related to Tropical Storm Sinlaku shall remain available for obligation and expenditure by *I Maga'hågan Guåhan* for emergency response, mitigation, and recovery activities associated with Tropical Depression 09W, including any escalation into a tropical storm or typhoon. Such expenses include, but are not limited to, costs related to safety and security; food, water, and sheltering; health and medical services;

energy; communications; transportation; and hazardous materials. Individual Assistance is authorized under this Section, supported by survey and damage assessment data. *I Maga'håga* shall disburse One Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$100,000) from the remaining funds to each mayor, who may utilize such monies for the purposes identified above. Mayors shall report all expenditures within forty-five (45) days of expenditure. *I Maga'håga* shall provide a written report of all expenditures under this Section, including those expended by the mayors, to I Liheslaturan Guåhan and the Public Auditor within sixty (60) days of initial disbursement and periodically thereafter.

Section 2. Effective Date. This Act shall be effective immediately.
